All officials interested in working at the tournament must complete and submit the Official's Application. Applications can be submitted via email to larsoga@uwec.edu or mail to the address on the form by February 11, 2022.

What should you bring to the tournament?

We suggest that everyone brings NFHS approved officiating gear. All officials must bring the following items with them:

- V-neck, short-sleeve black and white striped shirt(s) without side panels.
- Black undershirt, socks, shoes, pants (beltless, cuffless, pleated preferred)
- Whistle/lanyard (bring a back-up just in case)
- Great attitude
- Willingness to learn, open mind, and ability to receive constructive feedback

What do you get for working the tournament?

- \$60 stipend for the tournament
 - *Checks will be mailed to your Intramural Coordinator after the event*
- Experience, training, and discussion in working with 3-person mechanics
- Complimentary hotel on Saturday (Friday – as needed – if traveling a long distance).
- Continental breakfast at the hotel
