Mr. Robertson is a decorated, retired Marine Corps veteran. His twenty years of service spans numerous military/anti-terrorism operations and missions across the globe.

While on active duty he held a legal internship at the at the Department of Justice. There is participated in drafting the US PATRIOT ACT II and assisted in preparing cases against terrorists.

He is a former Deputy Director of Operations for Titan Corporation. His job duties involved supervising hundreds of military support linguists that were placed throughout the United States, Central America, the Middle East, Europe and Africa during the Global War on Terrorism. He is also responsible for training linguists on the Geneva Conventions – Law of Land Warfare and Rules of Engagements.

Mr. Robertson is currently the Sussex County Commonwealth's Attorney. He has held that position since April 21<sup>st</sup> of this year. Prior to his judicial appointment, he briefly served as Sussex County's Chief Deputy CA and as Assistant Commonwealth's Attorney from 2006 to 2008.

Mr. Robertson was also judicially appointed to serve as the Institutional Attorney at Sussex II prison. In that role, he was principally responsible for advising offenders concerning their posttrial relief (appeals) briefs.

He has many years of experience as a Guardian Ad Litem for both children and incapacitated adults. He has extensive experience as a juvenile defense attorney. Mr. Robertson has represented juveniles in thousands of delinquency cases, child abuse and neglect cases, child custody and truancy cases. This includes cases where the child was criminally charged as an adult.

He maintains several court-mandated certifications and is qualified to represent adult criminal defendants in many courts throughout the Commonwealth. He has major felonies case experience which includes cases involving rape, robbery, serious property crime, white collar crimes and murder. He has also received extensive training on death penalty cases. Mr. Robertson served on the Sussex County Court Appointed Counsel list from 2008 – 2012 where he represented defendants on a range of criminal matters such as possession of illegal narcotics, drug distribution, assault and battery and other felonies and misdemeanor cases.

He is certified to practice in the U.S. Federal District Courts for the Eastern District of Virginia. He has represented many notable clients, the most notable being Former Governor L. Douglas Wilder, Virginia's 66<sup>th</sup> Governor.

He holds a Bachelor of Science from Bluefield College, Master of Science from Troy State University and Juris Doctor from Regent University. Mr. Robertson is a former adjunct professor at Bluefield College and Park University.
