Sophomore (2006-07): Doubled his scoring average from his freshman season, averaging 14.1 points per contest...second on the team in assists after nearly tripling his assist total from his freshman year with 96...hit 37.6 percent (41-109) of his triple tries...hit 72.3 percent (86-119) of his free throws...scored in double-figures in 15 of his first 16 games and 26 of 29 on the year...scored 14 points on 5-of-10 shooting against Oklahoma State as a reserve after spraining his ankle at shoot-around (11/10)...played the full 40 minutes and scored 20 points against UMKC (11/13)...scored 17 points against Old Dominion (11/17)...hit the 20-point mark for the second time this season against Marist in 37 minutes on 7-of-13 shooting (11/19)...approached a triple-double against North Florida with 17 points, six assists and a career-high eight rebounds while going 5-for-10 from the floor (11/28)...averaged 15.0 points over his next three games (Florida Memorial, Norfolk State, UCF)...tied his career-high with seven assists against Norfolk State (12/02)...went 6-for-11 from the field, scoring 17 points against Troy and tying his career-high for three-point makes (four) before leaving with a sprained ankle...returned to the lineup as a reserve against UMKC, failing to reach 13 points for the first time that season (12/23)...returned to double-figures with a 14-point outing against Florida International (12/28)...scored 18 as a reserve on 5-of-7 shooting, including a 3-for-3 night from deep and a 5-for-7 night from the line, against Western Kentucky (12/30)...scored 13 points as a reserve against New Orleans while dishing out six assists (1/4)...scored eight points before leaving with an injury in the first half against Denver (1/18)...was just the second time this season he failed to reach double-figures in scoring...returned from injury to add 10 points against Louisiana-Lafayette (1/24)...went 5-for-11 from the field and 6-for-6 from the line to score 18 points against Arkansas-Little Rock (1/27)...scored 14 points and grabbed five rebounds to go with seven assists against Troy (2/3)...scored a career-high 22 points on 8-of-13 shooting and tied a career-high with seven assists against New Orleans (2/17)...sank 9-of-10 free throws in a 17-point effort against Middle Tennessee (2/24)...scored 17 points on 7-of-12 shooting against Florida International in the first round of the Sun Belt Tournament (2/28)...scored 10 points in the second round of the SBC Tournament against Western Kentucky (3/4).

Freshman (2005-06): One of two Owls nominated for Atlantic Sun All-Freshmen honors (Carlos Monroe)...averaged 7.0 points and 1.3 rebounds in 27 games, starting one...scored double-figure points eight times...posted 25 assists in his final eight games...one of four Owls with a positive assist-to-TO ratio (Brent Crews, Kevin Green, Ty McTyer)...had nine points, a career-best three steals and shot four-of-eight from the field in his collegiate debut at Colgate (11/18)...posted 10 points at Northwestern (11/21)...scored eight points in the second overtime and had career-high 20 points in a double-overtime win vs. Jacksonville (11/21)...set career highs for three-pointers made (three) and attempted (six) at USF (12/15)...five-of-five from the field with 11 points at Gardner-Webb (1/15)...first career block vs. Belmont (1/22)...set career marks for free throws made (five) and attempted (six) while scoring 16 points at Belmont (1/27)...made first career start at Lipscomb (1/29)...was four-of-six from the field with nine points and career-high three steals at Stetson (2/12)...poured in 12 points, five assists and two steals vs. ETSU (2/16)...raised his career bests for assists (seven) and rebounds (four) vs. Kennesaw State (2/18)...assisted on five buckets at Jacksonville (2/25).
