ESSENTIALS

Mileage: It is 11.7 miles around the Mineral Belt Trail. You may travel in either direction. The round metal mile markers rotate clockwise - see map.

Emergency: The trail has color marks on the pavement for emergency response location. Also, reference the nearest mile marker in the winter.

Winter Grooming: Check the current condition on the web site. Our snowcat operators get out shortly after storms.

Loppet Nordic Ski Race: annual event in late February. Details & registration for this 10, 22 & 44 kilometer event will be posted on the web site.

Shelters: located every couple miles for refuge. See the map.

Hazards: Leaving the Trail is discouraged. Historic structures are dangerous. Open mine shafts exist and the adjacent land is private.

Be Courteous: to the diverse trail users. Report violators and vandals. No vehicles are allowed. See other kiosk panels for additional rules.

Dogs: must be leashed (county law). Remove your dogs feces.

Donate: for maintenance and improvements. Tubes are provided at kiosks & can be mailed to: POBox 666, Leadville 80461 Consider a donor plaque on future benches - see web site for details.
