

I agree that I will keep the guardian ad litem informed of <b>any address and/o telephone number changes</b> that I have at all times prior to the time that I have completely paid my portion of the guardian ad litem's fees.
I agree that I will affirmatively seek to <b>establish a payment plan in good faith</b> with the guardian ad litem if I am unable to immediately pay as ordered by the Court the amounts due to the guardian ad litem.
I agree that I will not in any way, shape, form, or fashion <b>seek to avoid paying the guardian ad litem the amounts due</b> to the guardian ad litem as determined by the Court at the conclusion of this case. I will instead consistently keep the guardian ad litem apprised at all times of my good-faith efforts and progress in paying the amounts due.
