How to determine ring size:

You can use this sheet to determine the size of an existing ring. Make sure to select a ring that fits well on the desired finger.

Place the ring on the circles to the left. Find the size which most closely matches the inside edge of the ring. A very thin white line should still be visible around the circumference. If your ring seems to be between two sizes, use the larger one. This will be easier to resize later if needed.

If you are buying the ring as a surprise and do not have access to a ring of the proper size to measure, your best bet is to ask the recipient's parents or close friends for their size. If you can't get an exact finger size, remember that getting a large ring is much better than getting one that is too small.

If the ring is for you or is not a surprise, the most accurate way to get your ring size is to visit a local jeweler. Make sure the sizers are as close as possible to the width of the intended ring, as well as taking into consideration if it is comfort fit (domed inside) or not.

Your first ring sizing on any purchase from Gerber Jeweler is always free.*

* Ring must be gold or platinum to qualify for free sizing.
