01 - God Loves You & Wants a Relationship With You

God's Love: 'For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.' (John 3:16, ESV). 'And this is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.' (John 17:3, ESV). God desires for you to have a deep and personal knowledge of Him.
