CSLAP testing update: We are now just past the half way mark in our water quality testing for 2024. As you may know this shows us any changes to our lake's health.

SUNY Syracuse ESF is using our lake as part of their 2024/2025 capstone project. They will be sampling the soil on bottom of the lake and assisting with management plan.

2025 Projects:

Project WHIRL in partnership with Diana White and Clarkson University visited our lake to discuss potential funding for weevil control. Diane will return for another evaluation, and we hope to hear more in the coming months.

We have partnered with SUNY Syracuse ESF who will use our lake during the spring/fall semester to help us determine the best ways to allocate our funds for lake cleaning efforts. Additionally, we have contacted Millers Turf to conduct a weed evaluation to identify our major weed issues. Hyde Lake used them this year with great success.

We are considering purchasing Barley straw for next year to help with algae. A bag of barley would need to be placed every 100 feet along the shore. We will keep you informed on how you can get them for your area.
