LIGHT SWITCH REPAIR By Kevin Fielding

The last thing a Model A driver wants to see is this sign at 40 miles per hour.



But I found that the lack of bumps can be a problem, specifically when it comes to the light switch. This is a repair I did on the coupe a while back. I had just rebuilt the steering column and installed the small bushing under the light switch rod, but still had problems with

the lights turning on and off as I turned the steering wheel. Looking into the situation a bit further I found that the reproduction switch was lacking bumps, at least bumps that would hold the switch in place.

Using brass studs that are commonly used in leather working, I figured these were just the "bump" the fix needed. Prior to soldering make sure everything is completely clean. I first wire brushed with the Dremel and then cleaned the parts with a dilution of muriatic acid. A little flux and a touch of solder and we have bumps.







So from the photo you can see the difference it makes to have better bumps. It was a simple matter of putting a little grease on the bumps and putting them all back together. It was a bit tight so if I were to do this again I would cut the brass studs down just a bit to make assembly a bit easier.

And now for the final test, the lights work great, and best of all when they are on, they are on, and when they aren't they aren't.



Hope this helps a bit, and just remember it is just my way of making naked cats.
