The budget for 2019 was approved at the 11/15/2018 Board meeting. Budget numbers include:

Revenue:	\$608,107
Operating Expenses:	\$577,893

Manganese Treatment and Discolored Water

Manganese naturally occurs in rocks and soil and is accompanied by iron. Our Gallery well water contains iron and manganese for which we have a process in place to treat and filter. The treatment process was designed by an engineer and approved by CDPHE (Colorado Dept of Public Health and Environment). When the manganese comes in contact with chlorine it oxidizes and turns a brownish /black color. Some of the oxidized material settles in the water supply lines and can be stirred up when we are performing hydrant maintenance. Our annual hydrant flushing process is in place to flush the sediment from the lines as much as possible.

We are currently working with an engineer to improve the manganese treatment process which will reduce the amount of sediment in the lines. Once we have an improved treatment plan, it will be implemented at the earliest possible time. We are working to resolve the issue and thank you for your patience in this matter.
