Winterizing Tips

With winter around the corner and the cold weather we have been seeing, it is a good time to make sure your plumbing is winterized. Here are some tips:

- Insulate pipes exposed to the cold or located on outside walls.
- Wrap “problem area” pipes with electric heat tape. Inspect existing heat tape to make sure it is in good condition.
- Open the doors of your sink base cabinet so that warm air can reach water pipes.
- **Please don't leave water dripping** – it wastes water, raises your water bill, and can damage your septic system.
