## CAST

Gabriel Raphael Michael Mary Joseph Innkeeper Angel 1 (Gabriel) Angel 2 (Michael) Angel 3 (Raphael) King 1 King 2 King 3 Donkey shepherds

3 Angels enter 1 by 1 and admire the 'book of life'. First Michael. Then Raphael. Then Gabriel. They all stand round.

Together: I'm so excited!

Michael: Can you believe it's nearly time?

**Gabriel:** Feels like a gazillion years we've waited for this moment.

Raphael: And finally, it's here!

**Together**: The Book of life! Shall we?

Together they open it. One blows dust off it. They look at it in awe.

Michael: Everything recorded. Every name, every event. Ever.

Gabriel: And tomorrow we're all gonna be reunited for the best party ever!

They sigh nostalgically.

**Michael:** There's certainly been some ups and downs. I fought my socks off on behalf of so many.

**Gabriel**: You were certainly kept busy. Especially on for them lot in that little church on Silk Mill lane.

**Raphael**: What fun we had. What responsibility. We were sent to do some important jobs.

Michael: What was your fave?

**Raphael:** Oh! Remember when I rolled the stone away from the tomb. Did you see those guard's faces when it was empty?

**Gabriel**: All those important messages to pass on. Like when you told Mary and the disciples that the Lord was risen? Best day ever!!

**Michael**: We've certainly had some good times. But I'm pretty sure there was one particular highlight we can all agree on.

He points at a line in the book.

Gabriel: Oh Yes. The best one of all!

**Raphael** : And we all played a part in that bit of history.

**Michael**: Look here you are Gabriel! (they start narrating) God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a town in Galilee to a virgin pledged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of David. The virgin's name was Mary.

Mary enters carrying a basket. Angel 1 enters and in response Mary drops her basket.

**Angel 1:** Greetings, you who are highly favoured! The Lord is with you!

**Raphael:** Mary was greatly troubled at the angel's words and wondered what this might mean. But the angel said to her;

Mary enters, they embrace. The angels high five. Mary adds her bump off stage.

**Raphael**: In those days Caesar Augustus issued a decree that a census should be taken of the entire Roman world. And everyone went to his own town to register.

Mary returns with her bump, Joseph holding a letter.

**Joseph**: So I know you're nearly due but how do you feel about a few nights on the road?

Mary looks unconvinced at her tummy.

Mary: As long as we're together we'll be fine.

**Michael:** So, Joseph also went up from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to a place called Bethlehem to because he belonged to the house and line of David. He went there to register with Mary, who was pledged to be married to him and was expecting a child.

Gabriel: Let us sing (O little town of Bethlehem)

**Michael:** After a long and difficult journey to Bethlehem they finally made it and they completed their census. But they weren't the only ones heading there and Bethlehem

was busier than ever. In fact, it quickly became clear the journey wasn't the only difficulty Joseph had to overcome.

Mary: What do you mean there's no rooms left?

**Innkeeper:** We do have somewhere else actually. I've never let anyone stay there before but as the lady's expecting...

*He shows them the stable.* 

**Michael:** And while they were there, the time came for the baby to be born, and she gave birth to her firstborn, a son. She wrapped him in cloths and placed Him in a manger because there was no room for them in the inn.

Raphael: Let us sing. (Away in a Manager)

(Angel 1,2 and any others join)

Michael: Praising God and saying...

Michael: Let's sing (Hark the Herald Angels Sing)

**Raphael:** When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another...

**Shepherd**: Let us go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about.

The angels part revealing the manger

(Shepherds go to manger during song carrying lambs. Proceed one by one to fall down and worship. Mary and Joseph show baby to shepherds and let them hold the baby)

**Gabriel**: After Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the time of King Herod, Magi from the east came to Jerusalem.

Kings enter and examine their map..

Wise 1: That star doesn't seem to be on any of our charts.

Wise 2: I've been charting it for months too. What should we do?

Wise3: I know this isn't our usual approach but how about we follow it?

Wise 1: I suppose if we don't we'll never be any the wiser will we?

Wise 2: Wise guy huh?

Wise 3: Let's do it.

Gabriel: Let's sing (We Three Kings)

The kings process.

Gabriel: The kings asked,

**King 1:** Where is the one who was born King of the Jews? We saw his star in the east and have come to worship Him.

Mary points and they place their gifts.

King 1: Gold King 2: Frankincense King: Myrrh

Raphael: Let us sing. (Silent Night)

Raphael: The book doesn't mention it but we were there at the manger too weren't we?
