



# **Trial's Championship Regulations Revised 2021**

## **CHAMPIONSHIP SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**

All regulation changes for 2020 will appear in red and will be mandatory for all events from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020 onwards

### **THE CHAMPIONSHIP (Class)**

The BADLRC closed club trials championship is promoted and organized by Buxton & District Land Rover Club Ltd in accordance with the General Regulations of the MSA (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) Championship Permit No:- **Not Applicable.**

The Supplementary Regulations for trials and any written instructions the club may issue also apply.

### **ELIGIBILITY & ENTRIES**

This is an internal club class championship. Drivers that compete in one event will automatically be entered into the championship. With a maximum of there best EIGHT scores counting towards the championship. Drivers must be fully paid up members of Buxton & District Land Rover Club Ltd, using Land Rover based vehicles. In order to be eligible for the championship competitors will be required to assist in the set up a trial. You will not be eligible for the championship unless you comply.

### **THE CHAMPIONSHIP (Overall)**

The BADLRC closed club trials championship is promoted and organized by Buxton & District Land Rover Club Ltd in accordance with the General Regulations of the MSA (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) Championship Permit No:- **Not Applicable.**

The Supplementary Regulations for trials and any written instructions the club may issue also apply.

You may enter the overall championship in a non Landrover based vehicle.

### **ELIGIBILITY & ENTRIES**

This is an internal club overall championship. Drivers that compete in one event will automatically be entered into the championship. With a maximum of there best EIGHT scores counting towards the championship. Drivers must be fully paid up members of Buxton & District Land Rover Club Ltd, Vehicles need not be of Land rover origin.

### **REGISTRATION**

Drivers that compete in one or more events will be automatically entered into the championship. Overall and class along as applicable.

The entry fee for each event will be **£30**. Entries will be accepted on the morning of the events only. Postal entry is not required.

### **CHAMPIONSHIP SCORING (Class)**

Championship points will be allocated to competitors in each class at each event according to their finishing position at the end of each trial as follows

1st place 10 points  
2nd " 8 points  
3rd " 7 points  
4th " 6 points  
5th " 5 points  
6th " 4 points  
7th " 3 points  
8th " 2 points  
9<sup>th</sup> " 1 point

### **CHAMPIONSHIP SCORING (Overall)**

Championship points will be allocated to competitors at each event according to their finishing position at the end of each trial as follows

1st place 10 points  
2nd " 8 points  
3rd " 7 points  
4th " 6 points  
5th " 5 points  
6th " 4 points  
7th " 3 points  
8th " 2 points  
9<sup>th</sup> " 1 point

### **Two Day Events**

All competitors must enter both days to receive championship points. Both days count towards the championship with a maximum of 20 points over both days to be awarded .

A maximum of EIGHT rounds scores will count towards the final championship table. Championship Trophies (class & overall) will be presented at Buxton & District Land Rover Club's Dinner Dance.

Trophies will be awarded at the Dinner Dance at the end of the year. They will consist of one trophy with all the events the competitor has competed in throughout the year and there placing providing they placed in the top 3 for there class.

Results will be published and prize giving will take place as soon as practicable after the event. Full and final results will be published on Facebook and other social media.
