Images determined by the photographer to be substandard or duplicated may be edited out. The Photographer will use her professional judgment and sole discretion to select which photos to deliver. Such selection shall constitute all images that will be made available to Client.

Guests will have digital cameras and all your guests will want to photograph the Clients. In the spirit of cooperation the Clients agree to give the Photographers precedence over the guests in order to take the photographs required for the wedding services described above. We cannot be held liable for a lack of wedding photos if guests taking their own photos of the Clients continually interrupt the Photographer's work.

Unless agreed upon prior to any editing work, high-resolution discs and/or proof sets may contain a mixture of color, black and white, and selective color images. An alternately colored version of a photograph may be purchased at the current rate. Limited color correction and/or retouching is included at Photographer's discretion. Client may request further changes for an additional charge. Photographer is not responsible for any prints that are not ordered directly from her. For best results, clients with high-resolution files should order their prints through a reputable lab. As the author of all images made hereunder, and as provide for by United States Copyright Laws (Title 17, U.S. Code Section 101), the Photographer shall retain the copyrights in perpetuity, regardless of possession of ownership of photographs, digital files, or any other format of reproduction. Client recognizes and agrees that the Photographer may reproduce, publish (including internet), exhibit and otherwise use images created hereunder, without specific identification of persons or events, (1) as samples of work to be shown to prospective clients, (2) as samples of work to be displayed for marketing or competition.

If the Photographer cannot perform this agreement in whole or in part due to a fire or other casualty, acts of God or nature or terror, or other cause beyond the control of the parties or due to Photographer's illness or injury, then the Photographer will return all fees to the Client(s) but shall have no further liability with respect to this Agreement. This limitation on liability shall also apply in the event that photographic materials are damaged in processing, lost through camera malfunction, lost in the mail, or otherwise lost or damaged without fault on the part of the Photographer. Client(s) agree that an entire wedding cannot be replicated, reenacted or repeated for the purpose of a reshoot and limits the photographer's liability to the amount paid under this contract.

Upon signing of this agreement by both parties hereto, the photographer will reserve the time agreed upon and will not make another reservation for the specific time frame. For this reason, all deposits are non-refundable even if the date is changed or if the wedding is cancelled for any reason. Cancellation must be



made in writing, signed by the contracted party, and e-mailed to the Caroline Voisine, Cvoisine2010@gmail.com.

Upon receipt of a photo gallery, Client accepts all responsibility for archiving and protecting the photographs. Photographer does not permanently archive image files. Photographer is not responsible for the lifespan of any digital media provided or for any future changes in digital technology or media readers that might result in an inability to read files provided. It is the Client's responsibility to make sure that digital files are copied to new media as required. Photo Gallery and Files will be delivered to the Clients within 2 weeks of the event.
