TRADITIONAL VAPE



DISPOSABLE VAPE

 <p>BATTERY</p>	<p>Rechargeable</p>	<p>Some are rechargeable, but only till the juice runs out and is then disposed.</p>
 <p>NICOTINE</p>	<p>Salt nicotine or freebase nicotine options in varying strengths to zero nicotine.</p>	<p>Only available in high-concentration nicotine salts & sometimes zero nicotine.</p>
 <p>LIQUID</p>	<p>Refillable</p>	<p>Disposed of once liquid has run out.</p>
 <p>HIT</p>	<p>Most are adjustable and varying depending the device, e-liquid, and settings you choose.</p>	<p>Most provide roughly the same amount of vapor and hit.</p>
 <p>FLAVORS</p>	<p>Thousands of different flavor options with varying levels of flavor and nicotine strengths.</p>	<p>Hundreds of different flavors all strong nicotine and flavor but mostly sweet</p>
 <p>COIL</p>	<p>Once the coil or pod is burnt it is replaced. On average most people get about 2 weeks per coil.</p>	<p>Once the coil is burnt the unit is disposed of.</p>
 <p>COST</p>	<p>Start up cost of purchasing the unit can range from \$20-\$100 on average depending on the size of the unit but is an investment and typically cheaper to maintain over time. More cost effective.</p>	<p>Average cost of around \$20 per disposable at and an ongoing cost each time it burns out.</p>
