BATTERY LIFE

Rechargeable.

Traditional vapes, whether with internal or external batteries, can be recharged and, with proper maintenance, last anywhere from months to years.

Most on market today are rechargeable, but only until the battery dies, or juice is depleted, and then they are discarded.

NICOTINE

Salt nicotine and freebase nicotine options are available in many different strengths, including zero nicotine.

Typically only available in **high-concentration salt nicotine** & sometimes zero nicotine.

LIQUID & FLAVORS

Traditional vapes are refillable.

E-liquid sizes range from 10mL to 120mL.

Huge array of brands and flavor options, with different nicotine options.

Disposables **cannot be refilled.**They typically only contain between **12mL to 18mL** of juice.

Various flavors are offered, but there are no low-nicotine options.

HIT OR POWER

Many units provide **customizable settings** *to meet individual preferences*.

Your choice of unit should align with your specific needs or desires, as everyone has preferences when it comes to power.

Many disposable options offer similar vapor production, with some featuring slight adjustable settings.

COILS & PODS

Once the coil or pod is burnt, it should be swapped out.

They last approximately 2 weeks.

Once the coil is burnt the unit cannot be used any longer.

COST

The initial purchase of the unit can vary from \$20 to \$100 on average.

However, this is an investment that is generally more cost-effective to maintain in the long run.

The typical expense per disposable unit is approximately \$20, along with recurring costs each time it needs replacement.
