




HCPCA Financial Contribution to the community in 2022



Ghosh Park Renewal

Over the course of the spring months, construction will take place to renew Ghosh Park. This parkette is located located between Sai and Cellini Crescents. At the March 28, 2023 HCPCA meeting, Councillor Jessica Bradley informed residents that construction will be completed by June 2023. HCPCA will keep the community informed of any Ghosh Park Opening event. Residents can expect to see a new pathway, tactile walking surface and a new bench. There will be a combination of new and existing play structures. Landscaping will consist of engineered wood fibres, play sand, topsoil and sod.
