Zoning Amendment Application: VAW Housing Initiative Update

A Zoning Amendment application has been submitted for the vacant lot for the proposed Violence Against Women Housing Initiative (VAW) in Hunt Club Park. The proposal is for a new transitional housing facility that would provide a safe, supportive home for Inuit women and children. To facilitate the project, two zoning changes are being proposed by the applicant:

- · a site-specific exception to permit a Residential Care Facility
- · an increase in the maximum building height (from 10.7 to 11.5 metres)

Traffic Calming in Our Community

Traffic safety is one of my top priorities for our community, and my team and I work hard to address ongoing concerns. This year, we have launched a Traffic Calming Survey to evaluate the temporary measures that have been installed in 2024 on streets across the community. A reminder, Johnston Rd between Ewing Dr and Blohm Dr, has been selected for a Neighbourhood Traffic Calming Study, which includes the installation of permanent traffic calming measures. More details and opportunities for input to be announced soon.
