



We have seen a significant emphasis on mental health and wellbeing both for our life-at-home and our life-at-work. Mental health is our emotional. psychological, and social well-being affecting how we think and feel and impacting everything from how we interact with others to the decisions we make Mental Illness is health conditions such as anxiety or depression that affect our thinking, feelings, moods, or behaviours. 
