Rule 4.10e	An opt in on this rule is accepting all run rule options. An opt out of this rule means that you have no run rule exceptions.							
Rule 9.01c	An opt in on this rule is accepting that stealing signs is illegal and will incur a penalty. An opt out on this rule is accepting that stealing signs is allowed.							
Rule 6.02c	An opt in on this rule is accepting that the batter must adhere to this rule. An opt out on this rule is accepting that there is no warning or penalty for leaving the batter's box.							
Rule 4.10c	An opt in on this rule is accepting that there is no new inning after 1:45. An opt out is accepting that there is no time limit to a regulation game.							
Rule 7.14b	An opt in on this rule allows a local league to use a courtesy runner for its pitcher and catcher of record. An opt out of this rule means that no courtesy runners can be used.							
Rule 4.16a	An opt in on this rule allows a team to start a game 8 players. If a team only has 8 players at the start of a game, then the 9th batting position will be skipped and an out will be recorded. A 9th player (rostered) can be added at any time to the lineup removing the penalty. An opt out of this rule means that a team must have 9 players to start a game. If a team does not have 9 players at the start of the game, the game cannot be started. The game will be suspended for board review.							
Rule 4.17	An opt in to this rule allows a game to continue with 8 players if a player is removed for any reason. The removed player will be skipped and no penalty will be enforced. An opt out of this rule means that a game would be suspended if any team only has 8 available players (for any reason) after the game has begun.
