TIP-UP TOWN QUEEN CONTESTANT GUIDELINES

Queen Contestants shall:

1. Currently reside or be employed in Roscommon County. Minimum 18 years of age.
2. Represent a non-profit or charity that is active in Roscommon County. Contestants do not have to be a part of the Non-Profit/Charity.
3. Be an active member of the community, **this is not a beauty contest** & will be judged on their **knowledge of their Non-Profit/Charity and their community.**
4. Be willing and able to participate in all scheduled TUT 2025 activities. Including participation in the Memorial Day Parade (Hghtn. Lk.), July 4th Parade (Rosco.), Bluegill Festival (St. Helen), & Fireman's Memorial (Rosco).
5. The applications will be reviewed by the Queen's Committee and qualified applicants will continue as a Queen Candidate.
6. The Queen & court will be selected by a panel of judges, the Queen will receive a check for \$1,000. in the name of her chosen Charity and will be allotted a \$500. budget for gas and food to attend another community's parade of her choice with approval of the Chamber.
7. The Queen shall reign for a period of 1 year. If the Queen is unable to fulfill her obligations the runner up agrees to continue her rein.
8. It is understood that due to liability issues **ONLY the Queen, Court, Marshal and Mayor may ride on the TUT Float.**
9. Former Tip-Up Town USA Queens are not eligible.
