Beware of the Pharisees and Sadducees Doctrine

- 2 The Pharisees also with the Sadducees came, and tempting desired him that he would
- 3 shew them a sign from heaven. Mat 16:1 KJV
- 4 He answered and said unto them, When it is evening, ye say, [It will be] fair weather: for
- 5 the sky is red. Mat 16:2 KJV
- And in the morning, [It will be] foul weather to day: for the sky is red and lowring. O [ye]
- 7 hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky; but can ye not [discern] the signs of the
- 8 times? Mat 16:3 KJV
- 9 A wicked and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be
- 10 given unto it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas. And he left them, and departed. Mat 16:4
- 11 KJ\
- And when his disciples were come to the other side, they had forgotten to take bread. -
- 13 Mat 16:5 KJV
- 14 Then Yahshua said unto them, <u>Take heed and beware of the leaven of the</u>
- 15 Pharisees and of the Sadducees. Mat 16:6 KJV
- And they reasoned among themselves, saying, [It is] because we have taken no bread.
- 17 Mat 16:7 KJV
- 18 [Which] when Yahshua perceived, he said unto them, O ye of little faith, why reason ye
- among yourselves, because ye have brought no bread? Mat 16:8 KJV
- 20 Do ye not yet understand, neither remember the five loaves of the five thousand, and
- 21 how many baskets ye took up? Mat 16:9 KJV
- Neither the seven loaves of the four thousand, and how many baskets ye took up? Mat
- 23 16:10 KJV
- How is it that ye do not understand that I spake [it] not to you concerning bread, that ye
- 25 <u>should beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees?</u> Mat 16:11 KJV
- 26 Beware (Strong's Definitions Legend) H4337 προσέχω proséchō, pros-ekh'-o; from
- 27 G4314 and G2192; (figuratively) to hold the mind (3563 implied) towards, i.e. pay attention to,

28 29	be cautious about , apply oneself to, adhere to:—(give) attend(-ance, -ance at, -ance to, unto), beware, be given to, give (take) heed (to unto); have regard.
30	Then understood they how that he bade [them] not beware of the leaven of bread,
31	but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees Mat 16:12 KJV
32	Doctrine - Strong's G1322 – <i>didachē</i> - διδαχή - feminine noun - From <u>διδάσκω (G1321)</u> –
33 34 35 36 37 38	 teaching that which is taught doctrine, teaching, concerning something the act of teaching, instruction in religious assemblies of the Christians, to speak in the way of teaching, in distinction from other modes of speaking in public
39 40	(Strong's Definitions Legend) – G1322 - διδαχή didachḗ, did-akh-ay'; from G1321; instruction (the act or the matter):—doctrine, hath been taught.
41	What is a Rabbi?
42	Then spake Yahshua to the multitude, and to his disciples, - Mat 23:1 KJV
43	Saying, The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat: - Mat 23:2 KJV
44 45	All therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, [that] observe and do; but do not ye after their works: for they say, and do not $^{\rm Mat~23:3~KJV}$
46 47	For they bind heavy burdens and grievous to be borne, and lay [them] on men's shoulders; but they [themselves] will not move them with one of their fingers Mat 23:4 KJV
48 49	But all their works they do for to be seen of men: they make broad their phylacteries, and enlarge the borders of their garments, - $^{\rm Mat~23:5~KJV}$
50 51	And love the uppermost rooms at feasts, and the chief seats in the synagogues, - $^{\rm Mat\ 23:6}$ $_{\rm KJV}$
52	And greetings in the markets, and to be called of men, Rabbi, Rabbi $^{\rm Mat23:7KJV}$
53 54	Rabbi - Strong's G4461 – <i>rabbi -</i> ῥαββί - masculine noun - Of Hebrew origin <u>α (H7227)</u> with pronominal suffix –
55 56 57	 my great one, my honourable sir Rabbi, a title used by the Jews to address their teachers (and also honour them when not addressing them)
58 59	(Strong's Definitions Legend) – G4461 - ῥαββί rhabbí, hrab-bee'; of Hebrew origin (H7227 with pronominal suffix); my master, i.e Rabbi, as an official title of honor:—Master, Rabbi.
60 61	But be not ye called Rabbi: for one is your Master, [even] Messiah; and all ye are brethren $^{\rm Mat\ 23:8\ KJV}$

- And call no [man] your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven.
- 63 Mat 23:9 KJV

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- Neither be ye called masters: for one is your Master, [even] Messiah. Mat 23:10 KJV
- But he that is greatest among you shall be your servant. Mat 23:11 KJV
- And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself
- 67 shall be exalted. Mat 23:12 KJV
- But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye shut up the kingdom
- of heaven against men: for ye neither go in [yourselves], neither suffer ye (you let
- 70 go) them that are entering to go in. Mat 23:13 KJV
 - Yet they shall be ministers in my sanctuary, [having] charge at the gates of the house, and ministering to the house: they shall slay the burnt offering and the sacrifice for the people, and they shall stand before them to minister unto them. -Eze 44:11 KJV
 - Because they ministered unto them before their idols, and caused the house of Yisraal to fall into iniquity; therefore have I lifted up mine hand against them, saith Yahweh's Magistrate, and they shall bear their iniquity. - Eze 44:12 KJV
 - And they shall not come near unto me, to do the office of a priest unto me, nor to come near to any of my holy things, in the most holy [place]: but they shall bear their shame, and their abominations which they have committed. - Eze 44:13 KJV

The Pharisees Sadducees and Scribes are the Levites

- And Yahweh said unto me, Son of man, mark well, and behold with thine eyes, and hear
- 83 with thine ears all that I say unto thee concerning all the ordinances of the house of
- Yahweh, and all the laws thereof; and mark well the entering in of the house, with every
- 85 going forth of the sanctuary. Eze 44:5 KJV
- Thou son of man, shew the house to the house of Yisraal, that they may be ashamed of their iniquities: and let them measure the pattern. Eze 43:10 KJV
- And if they be ashamed of all that they have done, shew them the form of the house, and the fashion thereof, and the goings out thereof, and the comings in thereof, and all the forms thereof, and all the ordinances thereof, and all the forms thereof, and all the laws thereof: and write [it] in their sight, that they may keep the whole form thereof, and all the ordinances thereof, and do them. 94 95 96	This [is] the law of the house; Upon the top of the mountain the whole limit thereof round about [shall be] most holy. Behold, this [is] the law of the house. _ Eze 43:12 KJV
97 98 99	And thou shalt say to the rebellious, [even] to the house of Yisraal, Thus saith Yahweh's Magistrate; O ye house of Yisraal, <u>let it suffice you (you have done enough) of all your abominations</u> , - Eze 44:6 KJV
100 101 102	 But Yahweh was wroth with me for your sakes, and would not hear me: and Yahweh said unto me, Let it suffice thee; speak no more unto me of this matter Deu 3:26 KJV
103 104 105 106	In that ye have brought [into my sanctuary] strangers, uncircumcised in heart, and uncircumcised in flesh, to be in my sanctuary, to pollute it, [even] my house, when ye offer my bread, the fat and the blood, and they have broken my covenant because of all your abominations Eze 44:7 KJV
107 108	And ye have not kept the charge of mine holy things: but ye have set keepers of my charge in my sanctuary for yourselves $^{\rm Eze~44:8~KJV}$
109 110 111	Thus saith Yahweh's Magistrate; No stranger, uncircumcised in heart, nor uncircumcised in flesh, shall enter into my sanctuary, of any stranger that [is] among the children of Yisraal Eze 44:9 KJV
112 113	And the Levites that are gone away far from me, when Yisraal went astray, which went astray away from me after their idols; they shall even bear their iniquity Eze 44:10 KJV
114 115	 For the priest's lips should keep knowledge, and they should seek the law at his mouth: for he [is] the messenger of Yahweh of hosts Mal 2:7 KJV
116 117	 But ye are departed out of the way; ye have caused many to stumble at the law; ye have corrupted the covenant of Levi, saith Yahweh of hosts Mal 2:8 KJV
118 119 120	 Therefore have I also made you contemptible and base before all the people, according as ye have not kept my ways, but have been partial in the law Mal 2:9 KJV
121 122 123	Yet they shall be ministers in my sanctuary, [having] charge at the gates of the house, and ministering to the house: they shall slay the burnt offering and the sacrifice for the people, and they shall stand before them to minister unto them Eze 44:11 KJV
124 125 126	Because they ministered unto them before their idols, and caused the house of Yisraal to fall into iniquity; therefore have I lifted up mine hand against them, saith Yahweh's Magistrate, and they shall bear their iniquity Eze 44:12 KJV

139	Gods - Strong's H430 - 'ĕlōhîm – אֱלֹהִים - masculine noun - Plural of אַלוּהַ (H433) –
140 141 142 143 144 145 146 147 148 149	 (plural) rulers, judges divine ones angels gods (plural intensive - singular meaning) god, goddess godlike one works or special possessions of God the (true) God God
151 152 153 154 155	(Strong's Definitions Legend) – H430 - אֱלֹהִים 'ĕlôhîym, el-o-heem'; plural of H433; gods in the ordinary sense; but specifically used (in the plural thus, especially with the article) of the supreme God; occasionally applied by way of deference to magistrates; and sometimes as a superlative:—angels, × exceeding, God (gods) (-dess, -ly), × (very) great, judges, × mighty.
156 157	Speak unto all the congregation of the children of Yisraal, and say unto them, You shall be holy: for I Yahweh your Father [am] holy. Lev 19:2 KJV
158 159	Turn You not unto idols, nor make to yourselves molten gods: I [am] Yahweh your Father. Lev 19:4 KJV
160 161 162	And they shall not come near unto me, to do the office of a priest unto me, nor to come near to any of my holy things, in the most holy [place]: but they shall bear their shame, and their abominations which they have committed Eze 44:13 KJV
163 164	But I will make them keepers of the charge of the house, for all the service thereof, and for all that shall be done therein $^{\rm Eze~44:14~KJV}$
165 166 167 168	But the priests the Levites, the sons of Zadok , that kept the charge of my sanctuary when the children of Yisraal went astray from me, they shall come near to me to minister unto me, and they shall stand before me to offer unto me the fat and the blood, saith Yahweh's Magistrate: - Eze 44:15 KJV

169	Zadok - Strong's H6659 - șagoq – צָדוק – proper masculine noun - From <u>צָדה</u> (H6663) –
170	1. Zadok = "righteous"
171	1. the high priest, son of Ahitub of the house of Eleazar the son of Aaron, and 11th in
172 173	descent from Aaron; joined David after Saul's death and supported him against Absalom and Adonijah; anointed Solomon as king
173 174	2. a priest, son of Meraioth, father of Meshullam of the house of Ahitub; apparently a
175	nephew of 1
176	3. father of Jerusha, the wife of king Uzziah and mother of king Jotham of Judah
177	4. son of Baana and repairer of the wall of Jerusalem in the time of Nehemiah
178	son of Immer and repairer of the wall of Jerusalem in the time of Nehemiah
179	6. a leader of the people in the time of Nehemiah
180 181	7. a scribe appointed by Nehemiah as one of the treasurers over the storehouse8. a valiant warrior of the tribe of Benjamin who joined David at Hebron. Same as 1?
182 183	(Strong's Definitions Legend) – H6659 - צָּדוֹק Tsâdôwq, tsaw-doke'; from H6663; just; Tsadok, the name of eight or nine Israelites:—Zadok.
184 185	They shall enter into my sanctuary, and they shall come near to my table, to minister unto me, and they shall keep my charge $^{\rm Eze\ 44:16\ KJV}$
186 187 188	And it shall come to pass, [that] when they enter in at the gates of the inner court, they shall be clothed with linen garments; and no wool shall come upon them, whiles they minister in the gates of the inner court, and within Eze 44:17 KJV
189	Melchisedec Order existed before the Levitical Priesthood
190 191	For this Melchisedec, king of Salem, priest of the most high Yahweh, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings, and blessed him; - Heb 7:1 KJV
192 193	To whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all; first being by interpretation King of righteousness, and after that also King of Salem, which is, King of peace; - Heb 7:2 KJV
194 195	Without father, without mother, without descent, having neither beginning of days, nor end of life; but made like unto the Son of Yahweh; abideth a priest continually Heb 7:3 KJV
196 197	Now consider how great this man [was], unto whom even the patriarch Abraham gave the tenth of the spoils $^{\rm Heb\ 7:4\ KJV}$
198 199 200	And verily they that are of the sons of Levi, who receive the office of the priesthood, have a commandment to take tithes of the people according to the law, that is, of their brethren, though they come out of the loins of Abraham: - Heb 7:5 KJV
201 202	But he whose descent is not counted from them received tithes of Abraham, and blessed him that had the promises $^{\rm Heb~7:6~KJV}$
203	And without all contradiction the less is blessed of the better Heb 7:7 KJV

204	And here me	en that die	receive tithes	: but there he	[receiveth them]	. of whom it is

- witnessed that he liveth. Heb 7:8 KJV
- 206 And as I may so say, Levi also, who receiveth tithes, payed tithes in Abraham. Heb 7:9
- 207 KJV
- 208 For he was yet in the loins of his father, when Melchisedec met him. Heb 7:10 KJV
- 209 If therefore perfection were by the Levitical priesthood, (for under it the people
- received the law,) what further need [was there] that another priest should rise
- 211 after the order of Melchisedec, and not be called after the order of Aaron? Heb 7:11
- 212 KJ\
- 213 For the priesthood being changed, there is made of necessity a change also of the law.
- 214 Heb 7:12 KJV
- 215 For he of whom these things are spoken pertaineth to another tribe, of which no man
- 216 gave attendance at the altar. Heb 7:13 KJV
- For [it is] evident that our Ruler (Yahshua) sprang out of Juda; of which tribe Moses
- 218 spake nothing concerning priesthood. Heb 7:14 KJV
- 219 And it is yet far more evident: for that after the similitude of Melchisedec there ariseth
- 220 another priest, Heb 7:15 KJV
- 221 Who is made, not after the law (of sin and death) of a carnal commandment, but
- 222 after the power of an endless life. Heb 7:16 KJV
- For he testifieth, Thou [art] a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec. Heb 7:17
- 224 KJV
- For there is verily a disannulling of the commandment going before for the weakness
- 226 and unprofitableness thereof. Heb 7:18 KJV
- For the law (of sin and death) made nothing perfect, but the bringing in of a better
- 228 hope [did]; by the which we draw nigh unto Yahweh. Heb 7:19 KJV
- 229 And inasmuch as not without an oath [he was made priest]: Heb 7:20 KJV
- 230 (For those priests were made without an oath; but this with an oath by him that said
- unto him, Yahweh sware and will not repent, Thou [art] a priest for ever after the order of
- 232 Melchisedec:) Heb 7:21 KJV
- 233 By so much was Yahshua made a surety of a better testament. Heb 7:22 KJV
- 234 And they truly were many priests, because they were not suffered to continue by
- 235 reason of death: Heb 7:23 KJV

236 237	 Also there were many priests, because they were prevented by death from continuing Heb 7:23 NKJV
238 239	But this [man], because he continueth ever, hath an unchangeable priesthood $^{\mathrm{Heb}7:24}$ $_{\mathrm{KJV}}$
240 241	Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto Yahweh by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them $^{\rm Heb~7:25~KJV}$
242 243	For such an high priest became us, [who is] holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens; $ - ^{\text{Heb 7:26 KJV}} $
244 245	Who needeth not daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then for the people's: for this he did once, when he offered up himself $^{\text{Heb 7:27 KJV}}$
246 247 248	For the law maketh men high priests which have infirmity; but the word of the oath, which was since the law, [maketh] the Son, who is consecrated for evermore Heb 7:28 KJV
249	Identifying the Ministers of the Temple
250 251	For it is written in the law of Moses, Thou shalt not muzzle the mouth of the ox that treadeth out the corn. Doth Yahweh take care for oxen? - 1Co 9:9 KJV
252 253 254	Or saith he [it] altogether for our sakes? For our sakes, no doubt, [this] is written: that he that ploweth should plow in hope; and that he that thresheth in hope should be partaker of his hope $^{1\text{Co}\ 9:10\ \text{KJV}}$
255 256	If we have sown unto you spiritual things, [is it] a great thing if we shall reap your carnal things? - $^{1\text{Co}9:11\text{KJV}}$
257 258 259	If others be partakers of [this] power over you, [are] not we rather? Nevertheless we have not used this power; but suffer all things, lest we should hinder the gospel of Messiah $^{1\text{Co}9:12\text{KJV}}$
260 261	Do ye not know that they which minister about holy things live [of the things] of the temple? and they which wait at the altar are partakers with the altar? - $^{1\text{Co}9:13\text{KJV}}$
262 263	Even so hath Yahweh ordained that they which preach the gospel should live of the
