

1 VOLCANO GOD

Hephaestus was associated by Greek colonists in southern <u>Italy</u> with the <u>volcano</u> gods <u>Adranus</u> (of <u>Mount Etna</u>) and <u>Vulcanus</u> of the <u>Lipari</u> islands. The first-century sage <u>Apollonius of Tyana</u> is said to have observed, "there are many other mountains all over the earth that are on fire, and yet we should never be done with it if we assigned to them giants and gods like Hephaestus".

Nevertheless, Hephaestus' domain over fire goes back to Homer's *Iliad*, where he uses flames to dry the waters of Scamandrus river and force its homonym deity, who was attacking <u>Achilles</u>, to retreat.

Behold, the day of Yahweh cometh, and thy spoil shall be divided in the midst of thee. - Zec 14:1

For I will gather all nations against Yerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city. - Zec 14:2 KJV

Then shall Yahweh go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle. - Zec 14:3 KJV

And Judah also shall fight at Yerusalem; and the wealth of all the heathen round about shall be gathered together, gold, and silver, and apparel, in great abundance. - Zec 14:14 KJV

And so shall be the plague of the horse, of the mule, of the camel, and of the ass, and of all the beasts that shall be in these tents, as this plague. - ^{Zec 14:15 KJV}

And it shall come to pass, [that] every one that is left of all the nations which came against Yerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, Yahweh of hosts, and to keep the feast of tabernacles. - Zec 14:16 KJV

6 YAHWEH WILL SHAKE THE HEAVEN AND EARTH

In the seventh [month], in the one and twentieth [day] of the month, came the word of Yahweh by the prophet Haggai, saying, - Hag 2:1 KJV

Speak now to Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and to Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, and to the residue of the people, saying, - Hag 2:2 KJV

Who [is] left among you that saw this house in her first glory? and how do ye see it now? [is it] not in your eyes in comparison of it as nothing? - Hag 2:3 KJV

Yet now be strong, O Zerubbabel, saith Yahweh; and be strong, O Joshua, son of Josedech, the high priest; and be strong, all ye people of the land, saith Yahweh, and work: for I [am] with you, saith Yahweh of hosts: - Hag 2:4 KJV

[According to] the word that I covenanted with you when ye came out of Egypt, so my spirit remaineth among you: fear ye not. - Hag 2:5 KJV

For thus saith Yahweh of hosts; Yet once, it [is] a little while, and I will shake the heavens, and the earth, and the sea, and the dry [land]; - $^{\text{Hag 2:6 KJV}}$

I smote you with blasting and with mildew and with hail in all the labours of your hands; yet ye [turned] not to me, saith Yahweh. - Hag 2:17 KJV

Consider now from this day and upward, from the four and twentieth day of the ninth [month, even] from the day that the foundation of Yahweh's temple was laid, consider [it]. - Hag 2:18 KJV

Is the seed yet in the barn? yea, as yet the vine, and the fig tree, and the pomegranate, and the olive tree, hath not brought forth: from this day will I bless [you]. - Hag 2:19 KJV

And again the word of Yahweh came unto Haggai in the four and twentieth [day] of the month, saying, - Hag 2:20 KJV

And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and **there shall be a time of trouble**, such as never was since there was a nation [even] to that same time: and **at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book**. - Dan 12:1 KJV

And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame [and] everlasting contempt. - Dan 12:2 KJV

And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever. - $^{Dan\ 12:3\ KJV}$

- And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead
 which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. Rev 20:13

- And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. Rev 20:14 KJV
- And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire. Rev 20:15 KJV

I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spake: I beheld [even] till the beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame. - Dan 7:11 KJV

As concerning the rest of the beasts, they had their dominion taken away: yet their lives were prolonged for a season and time. - Dan 7:12 KJV

I saw in the night visions, and, behold, [one] like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. - Dan 7:13 KJV

And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion [is] an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom [that] which shall not be destroyed. - Dan 7:14 KJV

But the saints of the most High shall take the kingdom, and possess the kingdom for ever, even for ever and ever. - Dan 7:18 KJV

I beheld, and the same horn made war with the saints, and prevailed against them; - Dan 7:21 KJV

<u>Until the Ancient of days came</u>, and judgment was given to the saints of the most High; and the time came that the saints possessed the kingdom. - Dan 7:22 KJV

And he shall speak [great] words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time. - Dan 7:25 KJV

But the judgment shall sit, and they shall take away his dominion, to consume and to destroy [it] unto the end. - $^{\text{Dan 7:26 KJV}}$

And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose kingdom [is] an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him. - Dan 7:27 KJV
