1 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and
2 seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will
3 forgive their sin, and will heal their land. - 2Ch 7:14 KJV

4 **1 SHOW THEM THE HOUSE UPON THE MOUNTAIN**

5 And, behold, the glory of Yahweh of Yisraal came from the way of the east: and his
6 voice [was] like a noise of many waters: and the earth shined with his glory. - Eze 43:2 KJV

7 And [it was] according to the appearance of the vision which I saw, [even] according to
8 the vision that I saw when I came to destroy the city: and the visions [were] like the
9 vision that I saw by the river Chebar; and I fell upon my face. - Eze 43:3 KJV

10 And the glory of Yahweh came into the house by the way of the gate whose prospect
11 [is] toward the east. - Eze 43:4 KJV

12 So the spirit took me up, and brought me into the inner court; and, behold, the glory of
13 Yahweh filled the house. - Eze 43:5 KJV

14 And I heard [him] speaking unto me out of the house; and the man stood by me. - Eze 43:6
15 KJV

16 And he said unto me, Son of man, the place of my throne, and the place of the soles of
17 my feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Yisraal for ever, and my holy
18 name, shall the house of Yisraal no more defile, [neither] they, nor their kings, by their
19 whoredom, nor by the carcasses of their kings in their high places. - Eze 43:7 KJV

20 In their setting of their threshold by my thresholds, and their post by my posts, and the
21 wall between me and them, they have even defiled my holy name by their abominations
22 that they have committed: wherefore I have consumed them in mine anger. - Eze 43:8 KJV

23 Now let them put away their whoredom, and the carcasses of their kings, far from me,
24 and I will dwell in the midst of them for ever. - Eze 43:9 KJV

25 **Thou son of man, shew the house to the house of Yisraal, that they may be**
26 **ashamed of their iniquities: and let them measure the pattern.** - Eze 43:10 KJV

27 And if they be ashamed of all that they have done, shew them the form of the house,
28 and the fashion thereof, and the goings out thereof, and the comings in thereof, and all

29 the forms thereof, and all the ordinances thereof, and all the forms thereof, and all the
 30 laws thereof: and write [it] in their sight, that they may keep the whole form thereof, and
 31 all the ordinances thereof, and do them. - Eze 43:11 KJV

32 This [is] the law of the house; Upon the top of the mountain the whole limit thereof round
 33 about [shall be] most holy. Behold, this [is] the law of the house. - Eze 43:12 KJV

34 **2 THE MEASUREMENT OF THE ALTAR**

35 And these [are] the measures of the altar after the cubits: The cubit [is] a cubit and an
 36 hand breadth; even the bottom [shall be] a cubit, and the breadth a cubit, and the border
 37 thereof by the edge thereof round about [shall be] a span: and this [shall be] the higher
 38 place of the altar. - Eze 43:13 KJV

39 And from the bottom [upon] the ground [even] to the lower settle [shall be] two cubits,
 40 and the breadth one cubit; and from the lesser settle [even] to the greater settle [shall
 41 be] four cubits, and the breadth [one] cubit. - Eze 43:14 KJV

42 So the altar [shall be] four cubits; and from the altar and upward [shall be] four horns. -
 43 Eze 43:15 KJV

44 And the altar [shall be] twelve [cubits] long, twelve broad, square in the four squares
 45 thereof. - Eze 43:16 KJV

46 And the settle [shall be] fourteen [cubits] long and fourteen broad in the four squares
 47 thereof; and the border about it [shall be] half a cubit; and the bottom thereof [shall be] a
 48 cubit about; and his stairs shall look toward the east. - Eze 43:17 KJV

49 **3 THE OFFERING OF THE SACRIFICES**

50 And he said unto me, Son of man, thus saith Yahweh's Magistrate; These [are] the
 51 ordinances of the altar in the day when they shall make it, to offer burnt offerings
 52 thereon, and to sprinkle blood thereon. - Eze 43:18 KJV

53 And thou shalt give to the priests the Levites that be of the seed of Zadok, which
 54 approach unto me, to minister unto me, saith Yahweh's Magistrate, a young bullock for
 55 a sin offering. - Eze 43:19 KJV

56 And thou shalt take of the blood thereof, and put [it] on the four horns of it, and on the
 57 four corners of the settle, and upon the border round about: thus shalt thou cleanse and
 58 purge it. - Eze 43:20 KJV

59 Thou shalt take the bullock also of the sin offering, and he shall burn it in the appointed
 60 place of the house, without the sanctuary. - Eze 43:21 KJV

61 And on the second day thou shalt offer a kid of the goats without blemish for a sin
 62 offering; and they shall cleanse the altar, as they did cleanse [it] with the bullock. - Eze
 63 43:22 KJV

64 When thou hast made an end of cleansing [it], thou shalt offer a young bullock without
 65 blemish, and a ram out of the flock without blemish. - Eze 43:23 KJV

66 And thou shalt offer them before Yahweh, and the priests shall cast salt upon them, and
 67 they shall offer them up [for] a burnt offering unto Yahweh. - Eze 43:24 KJV

68 Seven days shalt thou prepare every day a goat [for] a sin offering: they shall also
 69 prepare a young bullock, and a ram out of the flock, without blemish. - Eze 43:25 KJV

70 Seven days shall they purge the altar and purify it; and they shall consecrate
 71 themselves. - Eze 43:26 KJV

72 And when these days are expired, it shall be, [that] upon the eighth day, and [so]
 73 forward, the priests shall make your burnt offerings upon the altar, and your peace
 74 offerings; and I will accept you, saith Yahweh's Magistrate. - Eze 43:27 KJV

75 **4 MARK WELL WHO MAY ENTER**

76 In my Father's house are many mansions: if [it were] not [so], I would have told you. I go
 77 to prepare a place for you. - Jhn 14:2 KJV

78 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself;
 79 that where I am, [there] ye may be also. - Jhn 14:3 KJV

80 And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know. - Jhn 14:4 KJV

81 Ye are they which have **continued with me** in my temptations. - Luk 22:28 KJV

82 And Yahshuaa said unto them, Verily I say unto you, **That ye which have**
 83 **followed me, in the regeneration when the Son of man shall sit in the**
 84 **throne of his glory, ye also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve**
 85 **tribes of Yisraal.** Mat 19:28 KJV

86 **And I appoint unto you a kingdom, as my Father hath appointed unto me;** - Luk 22:29 KJV

87 **2Pe 1:10-11 KJV**

88 ¹⁰ Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye
 89 do these things, ye shall never fall:

90 ¹¹ For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our
 91 King and Saviour Yahshua Messiah.

92 • And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name
 93 Yahshua. Luk 1:31 KJV

94 • He shall be great, and **shall be called the Son of the Highest: and Yahweh Almighty shall**
 95 **give unto him the throne of his father David:** Luk 1:32 KJV

96 • And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end. Luk
 97 1:33 KJV

98 **Appoint - Strong's G1303 – diatithēmi - διατίθημι – verb - Middle voice from δία (G1223) and**
 99 **τίθημι (G5087) –**

- 100 1. to arrange, dispose of, one's own affairs
 101 1. of something that belongs to one
 102 2. to dispose of by will, make a testament
 103 2. **to make a covenant, enter into a covenant**, with one

104 **(Strong's Definitions Legend) – G1303 - διατίθεμαι diatithemai, dee-at-ith'-em-ahee; middle**
 105 **voice from G1223 and G5087;** to put apart, i.e. (figuratively) dispose (by assignment, compact, or
 106 bequest):—appoint, make, testator.

107 That ye may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom, and sit on thrones judging the
 108 twelve tribes of Yisraal. - Luk 22:30 KJV

109 And Yahshua said unto them, Verily I say unto you, **That ye which have followed me,**
 110 **in the regeneration when the Son of man shall sit in the throne of his glory, ye**
 111 **also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Yisraal.** Mat 19:28 KJV

112 Thomas saith unto him, Ruler, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know
 113 the way? - Jhn 14:5 KJV

114 Yahshua saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: **no man cometh unto the**
 115 **Father, but by me.** - Jhn 14:6 KJV

116 If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye
 117 know him, and have seen him. - Jhn 14:7 KJV

118 Philip saith unto him, Ruler, **shew us the Father**, and it sufficeth us. - Jhn 14:8 KJV

119 Yahshua saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not
 120 known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou
 121 [then], Shew us the Father? - Jhn 14:9 KJV

- 122 • And thou shalt teach them ordinances and laws, and shalt shew them the way
 123 wherein they must walk, and the work that they must do. - Exo 18:20 KJV

124 And if they be ashamed of all that they have done, **shew them the form of the house,**
 125 and the fashion thereof, and the goings out thereof, and the comings in thereof, and all
 126 the forms thereof, and all the ordinances thereof, and all the forms thereof, and all the
 127 laws thereof: and write [it] in their sight, that they may keep the whole form thereof, and
 128 all the ordinances thereof, and do them. - Eze 43:11 KJV

129 **Form – (Strong's Definitions Legend) – H6699 - צורה tsûwrâh, tsoo-law'; feminine of H6697; a**
 130 **rock (Job 28:10); also a form (as if pressed out):—form, rock.**

(Strong's Definitions Legend) – צור *tsûwr*, *tsoor*; or צָר *tsur*; from - 6697 *tsuwr tsoor* or *tsur {tsoor}*; from 6696; properly, a cliff (or sharp rock, as compressed); generally, **a rock** or boulder; figuratively, a refuge; also an edge (as precipitous):--edge, X (mighty) God (one), rock, X sharp, stone, X strength, X strong. See also 1049.

- Yahweh [is] **my rock**, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my Father, my **strength**, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, [and] my high tower. - Psa 18:2 KJV
- For who [is] God save Yahweh? or who [is] **a rock** save our Father? - Psa 18:31 KJV
- Yahweh liveth; and blessed [be] **my rock**; and let the Father of my salvation be exalted. - Psa 18:46 KJV
- Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O Yahweh, my **strength**, and my redeemer. - Psa 19:14 KJV
- For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon **a rock**. - Psa 27:5 KJV
- In Salem (Peace, Yerusalem) also is his tabernacle (**pavilion**), and his dwelling place in Zion (David, the City of David, the Messiah). - Psa 76:2 KJV
- **Yerusalem above is free and Yerusalem below is in bondage.**

Then he brought me back the way of the gate of the outward sanctuary which looketh toward the east; and it [was] shut. - Eze 44:1 KJV

Then said Yahweh unto me; This gate shall be shut, it shall not be opened, and no man shall enter in by it; because Yahweh, the Father of Yisraal, hath entered in by it, therefore it shall be shut. - Eze 44:2 KJV

- Blow up the trumpet in the new moon, in the time appointed, on our solemn feast day. - Psa 81:3 KJV
- And it shall come to pass, [that] from one new moon to another, and from one sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to worship before me, saith Yahweh. - Isa 66:23 KJV
- And they shall go forth, and look upon the carcasses of the men that have transgressed against me: for their worm shall not die, neither shall their fire be quenched; and they shall be an abhorring unto all flesh. - Isa 66:24 KJV
- Thus saith Yahweh's Magistrate; The gate of the inner court that looketh toward the east shall be shut the six working days; but on the sabbath it shall be opened, and in the day of the new moon it shall be opened. - Eze 46:1 KJV
- And the prince shall enter by the way of the porch of [that] gate without, and shall stand by the post of the gate, and the priests shall prepare his burnt offering and his peace offerings, and he shall worship at the threshold of the gate: then he shall go forth; but the gate shall not be shut until the evening. - Eze 46:2 KJV

170 • Likewise the people of the land shall worship at the door of this gate before
 171 Yahweh in the sabbaths and in the new moons. - Eze 46:3 KJV

172 [It is] for the prince; the prince, he shall sit in it to eat bread before Yahweh; he shall
 173 enter by the way of the porch of [that] gate, and shall go out by the way of the same. -
 174 Eze 44:3 KJV

175 Then brought he me the way of the north gate before the house: and I looked, and,
 176 behold, the glory of Yahweh filled the house of Yahweh: and I fell upon my face. - Eze 44:4
 177 KJV

178 And Yahweh said unto me, **Son of man, mark well**, and behold with thine eyes, and
 179 hear with thine ears all that I say unto thee concerning all the ordinances of the house of
 180 Yahweh, and all the laws thereof; and mark well the entering in of the house, with every
 181 going forth of the sanctuary. - Eze 44:5 KJV

182 And thou shalt say to the rebellious, [even] to the house of Yisraal, Thus saith Yahweh's
 183 Magistrate; O ye house of Yisraal, let it suffice you of all your abominations, - Eze 44:6 KJV

184 In that ye have brought [~~into my sanctuary~~] strangers, uncircumcised in heart, and
 185 uncircumcised in flesh, to be in my sanctuary, to pollute it, [even] my house, when ye
 186 offer my bread, the fat and the blood, and they have broken my covenant because of all
 187 your abominations. - Eze 44:7 KJV

188 And ye have not kept the charge of mine holy things: but ye have set keepers of my
 189 charge in my sanctuary for yourselves. - Eze 44:8 KJV

190 Thus saith Yahweh's Magistrate; No stranger, uncircumcised in heart, nor
 191 uncircumcised in flesh, shall enter into my sanctuary, of any stranger that [is] among the
 192 children of Yisraal. - Eze 44:9 KJV

193 And the Levites that are gone away far from me, when Yisraal went astray, which went
 194 astray away from me after their idols; they shall even bear their iniquity. - Eze 44:10 KJV

195 Yet they shall be ministers in my sanctuary, [having] charge at the gates of the house,
 196 and ministering to the house: they shall slay the burnt offering and the sacrifice for the
 197 people, and they shall stand before them to minister unto them. - Eze 44:11 KJV

198 Because they ministered unto them before their idols, and caused the house of Yisraal
 199 to fall into iniquity; therefore have I lifted up mine hand against them, saith Yahweh's
 200 Magistrate, and they shall bear their iniquity. - Eze 44:12 KJV

201 And they shall not come near unto me, to do the office of a priest unto me, nor to come
 202 near to any of my holy things, in the most holy [place]: but they shall bear their shame,
 203 and their abominations which they have committed. - Eze 44:13 KJV

204 But I will make them keepers of the charge of the house, for all the service thereof, and
 205 for all that shall be done therein. - Eze 44:14 KJV

206 But the priests the Levites, the sons of Zadok, that kept the charge of my sanctuary
 207 when the children of Yisraal went astray from me, they shall come near to me to
 208 minister unto me, and they shall stand before me to offer unto me the fat and the blood,
 209 saith Yahweh's Magistrate: - Eze 44:15 KJV

210 They shall enter into my sanctuary, and they shall come near to my table, to minister
 211 unto me, and they shall keep my charge. - Eze 44:16 KJV

212 And it shall come to pass, [that] when they enter in at the gates of the inner court, they
 213 shall be clothed with linen garments; and no wool shall come upon them, whiles they
 214 minister in the gates of the inner court, and within. - Eze 44:17 KJV

215 They shall have linen bonnets upon their heads, and shall have linen breeches upon
 216 their loins; they shall not gird [themselves] with any thing that causeth sweat. - Eze 44:18
 217 KJV

218 And when they go forth into the utter court, [even] into the utter court to the people, they
 219 shall put off their garments wherein they ministered, and lay them in the holy chambers,
 220 and they shall put on other garments; and they shall not sanctify the people with their
 221 garments. - Eze 44:19 KJV

222 Neither shall they shave their heads, nor suffer their locks to grow long; they shall only
 223 poll their heads. - Eze 44:20 KJV

224 Neither shall any priest drink wine, when they enter into the inner court. - Eze 44:21 KJV

225 Neither shall they take for their wives a widow, nor her that is put away: but they shall
 226 take maidens of the seed of the house of Yisraal, or a widow that had a priest before. -
 227 Eze 44:22 KJV

228 And they shall teach my people [the difference] between the holy and profane, and
 229 cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean. - Eze 44:23 KJV

230 And in controversy they shall stand in judgment; [and] they shall judge it according to
 231 my judgments: and they shall keep my laws and my statutes in all mine assemblies; and
 232 they shall hallow my sabbaths. - Eze 44:24 KJV

233 And they shall come at no dead person to defile themselves: but for father, or for
 234 mother, or for son, or for daughter, for brother, or for sister that hath had no husband,
 235 they may defile themselves. - Eze 44:25 KJV

236 And after he is cleansed, they shall reckon unto him seven days. - Eze 44:26 KJV

237 And in the day that he goeth into the sanctuary, unto the inner court, to minister in the
 238 sanctuary, he shall offer his sin offering, saith Yahweh's Magistrate. - Eze 44:27 KJV

239 And it shall be unto them for an inheritance: I [am] their inheritance: and ye shall give
 240 them no possession in Yisraal: I [am] their possession. - Eze 44:28 KJV

241 They shall eat the meat offering, and the sin offering, and the trespass offering; and
 242 every dedicated thing in Yisraal shall be theirs. - Eze 44:29 KJV

243 And the first of all the firstfruits of all [things], and every oblation of all, of every [sort] of
 244 your oblations, shall be the priest's: ye shall also give unto the priest the first of your
 245 dough, that he may cause the blessing to rest in thine house. - Eze 44:30 KJV

246 The priests shall not eat of any thing that is dead of itself, or torn, whether it be fowl or
 247 beast. - Eze 44:31 KJV

248 **5 SIGNS TO PREPARE FOR THE GREAT EARTHQUAKE AND DELIVERANCE**

249 But of that day and hour knoweth no [man], no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father
 250 only. - Mat 24:36 KJV

251 But as the days of Noe [were], so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. - Mat 24:37
 252 KJV

253 For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying
 254 and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, - Mat 24:38 KJV

255 And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of
 256 the Son of man be. - Mat 24:39 KJV

257 Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left. - Mat 24:40 KJV

258 Two [women shall be] grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left. - Mat
 259 24:41 KJV

260 Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come. - Mat 24:42 KJV

261 But know this, that if the goodman of the house had known in what watch the thief
 262 would come, he would have watched, and would not have suffered his house to be
 263 broken up. - Mat 24:43 KJV

264 Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.
 265 - Mat 24:44 KJV

266 And the Jews' passover was at hand, and Yahshua went up to Yerusalem, - Jhn 2:13 KJV

267 And found in the temple those that sold oxen and sheep and doves, and the changers
 268 of money sitting: - Jhn 2:14 KJV

269 And when he had made a scourge of small cords, he drove them all out of the temple,
 270 and the sheep, and the oxen; and poured out the changers' money, and overthrew the
 271 tables; - Jhn 2:15 KJV

272 And said unto them that sold doves, Take these things hence; make not my Father's
 273 house an house of merchandise. - Jhn 2:16 KJV

274 And his disciples remembered that it was written, The zeal of thine house hath eaten
 275 me up. - Jhn 2:17 KJV

276 Then answered the Jews and said unto him, What sign shewest thou unto us, seeing
 277 that thou doest these things? - Jhn 2:18 KJV

278 Jesus answered and said unto them, Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it
 279 up. - Jhn 2:19 KJV

280 Then said the Jews, Forty and six years was this temple in building, and wilt thou rear it
 281 up in three days? - Jhn 2:20 KJV

282 But he spake of the temple of his body. - Jhn 2:21 KJV

283 When therefore he was risen from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said
 284 this unto them; and they believed the scripture, and the word which Yahshua had said. -
 285 Jhn 2:22 KJV

286 And he looked up, and saw the rich men casting their gifts into the treasury. - Luk 21:1 KJV

287 And he saw also a certain poor widow casting in thither two mites. - Luk 21:2 KJV

288 And he said, Of a truth I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast in more than they
 289 all: - Luk 21:3 KJV

290 For all these have of their abundance cast in unto the offerings of Yahweh: but she of
 291 her penury hath cast in all the living that she had. - Luk 21:4 KJV

292 And as some spake of the temple, how it was adorned with goodly stones and gifts, he
 293 said, - Luk 21:5 KJV

294 [As for] these things which ye behold, the days will come, in the which there shall not be
 295 left one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down. - Luk 21:6 KJV

296 And they asked him, saying, Master, but when shall these things be? and what sign [will
 297 there be] when these things shall come to pass? - Luk 21:7 KJV

298 And he said, Take heed that ye be not deceived: for many shall come in my name,
 299 saying, I am [Messiah]; and the time draweth near: go ye not therefore after them. - Luk
 300 21:8 KJV

301 But when ye shall hear of wars and commotions, be not terrified: for these things must
 302 first come to pass; but the end [is] not by and by. - Luk 21:9 KJV

303 Then said he unto them, Nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom:
 304 - Luk 21:10 KJV

305 And great earthquakes shall be in divers places, and famines, and pestilences; and
 306 fearful sights and great signs shall there be from heaven. - Luk 21:11 KJV

307 But before all these, they shall lay their hands on you, and persecute [you], delivering
 308 [you] up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for
 309 my name's sake. - Luk 21:12 KJV

310 And it shall turn to you for a testimony. - Luk 21:13 KJV

311 Settle [it] therefore in your hearts, not to meditate before what ye shall answer: - Luk 21:14
 312 KJV

313 For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to
 314 gainsay nor resist. - Luk 21:15 KJV

315 And ye shall be betrayed both by parents, and brethren, and kinsfolks, and friends; and
 316 [some] of you shall they cause to be put to death. - Luk 21:16 KJV

317 And ye shall be hated of all [men] for my name's sake. - Luk 21:17 KJV

318 But there shall not an hair of your head perish. - Luk 21:18 KJV

319 In your patience possess ye your souls. - Luk 21:19 KJV

320 And when ye shall see Yerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the
 321 desolation thereof is nigh. - Luk 21:20 KJV

322 Then let them which are in **Judaea flee to the mountains**; and let them which are in
 323 the midst of it depart out; and let not them that are in the countries enter thereinto. - Luk
 324 21:21 KJV

325 For these be the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled. -
 326 Luk 21:22 KJV

327 But woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck, in those days! for
 328 there shall be great distress in the land, and wrath upon this people. - Luk 21:23 KJV

329 And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and shall be led away captive into all
 330 nations: and Yerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles, until the times of the
 331 Gentiles be fulfilled. - Luk 21:24 KJV

332 And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the
 333 earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring; - Luk 21:25 KJV

334 Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming
 335 on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken. - Luk 21:26 KJV

336 And then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. -
 337 Luk 21:27 KJV

338 And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for
 339 your redemption draweth nigh. - Luk 21:28 KJV

340 And Yahshua went out, and departed from the temple: and his disciples came to [him]
 341 for to shew him the buildings of the temple. - Mat 24:1 KJV

342 And Yahshua said unto them, See ye not all these things? verily I say unto you, There
 343 shall not be left here one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down. - Mat 24:2 KJV

344 And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying,
 345 Tell us, when shall these things be? and what [shall be] the sign of thy coming, and of
 346 the end of the world? - Mat 24:3 KJV

347 And Yahshua answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you. - Mat
 348 24:4 KJV

349 For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Messiah; and shall deceive many. - Mat
 350 24:5 KJV

351 And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all
 352 [these things] must come to pass, but the end is not yet. - Mat 24:6 KJV

353 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be
 354 famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places. - Mat 24:7 KJV

355 All these [are] the beginning of sorrows. - Mat 24:8 KJV

356 Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of
 357 all nations for my name's sake. - Mat 24:9 KJV

358 And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one
 359 another. - Mat 24:10 KJV

360 And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many. - Mat 24:11 KJV

361 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold. - Mat 24:12 KJV

362 But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. - Mat 24:13 KJV

363 And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all
 364 nations; and then shall the end come. - Mat 24:14 KJV

365 When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the
 366 prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:) - Mat 24:15 KJV

367 • But when ye shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the
 368 prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that readeth understand,) then let
 369 them that be in **Judaea flee to the mountains:** - Mar 13:14 KJV

370 Then let them which be in **Judaea flee into the mountains:** - Mat 24:16 KJV

371 Let him which is on the housetop (**Mountain Top**) not come down to take any thing out
 372 of his house: - Mat 24:17 KJV

- 373 Neither let him which is in the field return back to take his clothes. - Mat 24:18 KJV
- 374 And woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck in those days! - Mat
375 24:19 KJV
- 376 But pray ye that your flight be not in the winter, neither on the sabbath day: - Mat 24:20 KJV
- 377 For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to
378 this time, no, nor ever shall be. - Mat 24:21 KJV
- 379 And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the
380 elect's sake those days shall be shortened. - Mat 24:22 KJV
- 381 Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here [is] Messiah, or there; believe [it] not. - Mat
382 24:23 KJV
- 383 For there shall arise false Messiahs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and
384 wonders; insomuch that, if [it were] possible, they shall deceive the very elect. - Mat 24:24
385 KJV
- 386 Behold, I have told you before. - Mat 24:25 KJV
- 387 Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, he is in the desert; go not forth: behold,
388 [he is] in the secret chambers; believe [it] not. - Mat 24:26 KJV
- 389 For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall
390 also the coming of the Son of man be. - Mat 24:27 KJV
- 391 For wheresoever the carcase is, there will the eagles be gathered together. - Mat 24:28 KJV
- 392 Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon
393 shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the
394 heavens shall be shaken: - Mat 24:29 KJV
- 395 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes
396 of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven
397 with power and great glory. - Mat 24:30 KJV
- 398 And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather
399 together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other. - Mat 24:31 KJV
- 400 Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet tender, and putteth forth
401 leaves, ye know that summer [is] nigh: - Mat 24:32 KJV
- 402 So likewise ye, when ye shall see all these things, know that it is near, [even] at the
403 doors. - Mat 24:33 KJV
- 404 Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled. - Mat
405 24:34 KJV
- 406 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away. - Mat 24:35 KJV

407 But of that day and hour knoweth no [man], no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father
 408 only. - Mat 24:36 KJV

409 But as the days of Noe [were], so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. - Mat 24:37
 410 KJV

411 For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying
 412 and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, - Mat 24:38 KJV

413 And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of
 414 the Son of man be. - Mat 24:39 KJV

415 Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left. - Mat 24:40 KJV

416 Two [women shall be] grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left. - Mat
 417 24:41 KJV

418 Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come. - Mat 24:42 KJV

419 But know this, that if the goodman of the house had known in what watch the thief
 420 would come, he would have watched, and would not have suffered his house to be
 421 broken up. - Mat 24:43 KJV

422 Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.
 423 - Mat 24:44 KJV

424 Who then is a faithful and wise servant, whom his lord hath made ruler over his
 425 household, to give them meat in due season? - Mat 24:45 KJV

426 Blessed [is] that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing. - Mat 24:46 KJV

427 Verily I say unto you, That he shall make him ruler over all his goods. - Mat 24:47 KJV

428 But and if that evil servant shall say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming; - Mat 24:48
 429 KJV

430 And shall begin to smite [his] fellowservants, and to eat and drink with the drunken; - Mat
 431 24:49 KJV

432 The lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looketh not for [him], and in an
 433 hour that he is not aware of, - Mat 24:50 KJV

434 And shall cut him asunder, and appoint [him] his portion with the hypocrites: there shall
 435 be weeping and gnashing of teeth. - Mat 24:51 KJV
