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Understanding the truth of Religion

The Greek word *threskeia*, which was used by Greek writers such as Herodotus and Josephus, is found in the New Testament. *Threskeia* is sometimes translated as religion in today's translations, however, the term was understood as worship well into the medieval period.^[3] In the Quran, the Arabic word *din* is often translated as religion in modern translations, **but up to the mid-1600s translators expressed *din* as law.**^[3]

The **Sanskrit** word **dharma**, sometimes translated as religion,^[39] also means **law**. Throughout classical **South Asia**, the study of law consisted of concepts such as penance through piety and ceremonial as well as practical traditions. Medieval Japan at first had a similar union between imperial law and universal or Buddha law, but these later became independent sources of power.^{[40][41]}

Though traditions, sacred texts, and practices have existed throughout time, most cultures did not align with Western conceptions of religion since they did not separate everyday life from the sacred. In the 18th and 19th centuries, the terms Buddhism, Hinduism, Taoism, Confucianism, and world religions first entered the English language.^{[42][43][44]} No one self-identified as a Hindu or Buddhist or other similar terms before the 1800s.^[45] "Hindu" has historically been used as a geographical, cultural, and later religious identifier for people indigenous to the **Indian subcontinent**.^{[46][47]} Throughout its long history, Japan had no concept of religion since there was no corresponding Japanese word, nor anything close to its meaning, but when American warships appeared off the coast of Japan in 1853 and forced the Japanese government to sign treaties demanding, among other things, freedom of religion, the country had to contend with this idea.^{[48][49]}

According to the **philologist Max Müller** in the 19th century, the root of the English word religion, the **Latin** *religio*, was originally used to mean only reverence for God or the gods, careful pondering of divine things, piety (which Cicero further derived to mean diligence).^{[50][51]} **Max Müller** characterized many other cultures around the world, including Egypt, Persia, and India, as having a similar power structure at this point in history. **What is called ancient religion today, they would have only called **law**.**^[52]

The original discovery of religions in different cultures was rooted in the assumption that each people had its own divine "revelation," or at least its own parallel to Christianity. In the same period, however, European and American explorers often suggested that specific African or Native American tribes lacked religion altogether. Instead these groups were reputed to have only superstitions and as such they were seen as less than human.

Representation at the Parliament was not comprehensive. Naturally, Christians dominated the meeting, and Jews were represented. Muslims were represented by a single American Muslim. The enormously diverse traditions of India were represented by a single teacher, while three teachers represented the arguably more homogenous strains of Buddhist thought. The indigenous religions of the Americas and Africa were not represented. Nevertheless, since the convening of the Parliament, Judaism, Christianity, Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism, Confucianism, and Taoism have been commonly identified as World Religions. They are sometimes called the "Big Seven" in Religious Studies textbooks, and many generalizations about religion have been derived from them.

 682 judgments: and all the people answered with one voice, and said, All the words
 683 which Yahweh hath said will we do. Exo 24:3 KJV

684 And Moses wrote all the words of Yahweh, and rose up early in the morning, and
 685 builded an altar under the hill, and twelve pillars, according to the twelve tribes of
 686 Yisraal. Exo 24:4 KJV

687 And he sent young men of the children of Yisraal, which offered burnt offerings,
 688 and sacrificed peace offerings of oxen unto Yahweh. Exo 24:5 KJV

689 And Moses took half of the blood, and put [it] in basons; and half of the blood he
 690 sprinkled on the altar. Exo 24:6 KJV

691 The Book of the Blood of the Covenant

692 And he took **the book of the covenant**, and read in the audience of the people:
 693 and they said, All that Yahweh hath said will we do, and be obedient. Exo 24:7 KJV

694 And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled [it] on the people, and said, Behold the
 695 blood of the covenant, which Yahweh hath made with you concerning all these
 696 words. Exo 24:8 KJV

697 And I will establish my covenant with you; neither shall all flesh be cut off any more by
 698 the waters of a flood; neither shall there any more be a flood to destroy the earth. Gen 9:11
 699 KJV

700 And I will remember my covenant, which [is] between me and you and every living
 701 creature of all flesh; and the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh.
 702 Gen 9:15 KJV

703 And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I may remember the
 704 everlasting covenant between Yahweh and every living creature of all flesh that [is]
 705 upon the earth. Gen 9:16 KJV

706 And Yahweh said unto Noah, This [is] the token of the covenant, which I have
 707 established between me and all flesh that [is] upon the earth. Gen 9:17 KJV

708 In that ye have brought [into my sanctuary] strangers, uncircumcised in heart, and
 709 uncircumcised in flesh, to be in my sanctuary, to pollute it, [even] my house, when ye
 710 offer my bread, the fat and the blood, and they have broken my covenant because of all
 711 your abominations. Eze 44:7 KJV

712 **Blood of Atonement**

713 **Lev 17:1-10 KJV**

714 ¹ And Yahweh spake unto Moses, saying,

715 ² Speak unto Aaron, and unto his sons, and unto all the children of Yisraal, and say unto
716 them; This [is] the thing which Yahweh hath commanded, saying,

717 ³ What man soever [there be] of the house of Yisraal, that killeth an ox, or lamb, or goat,
718 in the camp, or that killeth [it] out of the camp,

719 ⁴ And bringeth it not unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, to offer an
720 offering unto Yahweh before the tabernacle of Yahweh; blood shall be imputed unto that
721 man; **he hath shed blood**; and that man shall be cut off from among his people:

722 • But flesh with the life thereof, [which is] the blood thereof, shall ye not eat. - Gen 9:4
723 KJV

724 • And surely your blood of your lives will I require; at the hand of every beast will I
725 require it, and at the hand of man; at the hand of every man's brother will I
726 require the life of man. - Gen 9:5 KJV

727 • **Whoso sheddeth man's blood**, by man shall his blood be shed: for in the image
728 of Yahweh made he man. - Gen 9:6 KJV

729 ⁵ To the end that the children of Yisraal may bring their sacrifices, which they offer in the
730 open field, even that they may bring them unto Yahweh, unto the door of the tabernacle
731 of the congregation, unto the priest, and offer them [for] peace offerings unto Yahweh.

732 ⁶ And the priest shall sprinkle the blood upon the altar of Yahweh [at] the door of the
733 tabernacle of the congregation, and burn the fat for a sweet savour unto Yahweh.

734 ⁷ **And they shall no more offer their sacrifices unto devils**, after whom they have
735 gone a whoring. This shall be a statute for ever unto them throughout their generations.

736 ⁸ And thou shalt say unto them, Whatsoever man [there be] of the house of Yisraal, or
737 of the strangers which sojourn among you, that offereth a burnt offering or sacrifice,

738 ⁹ And bringeth it not unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, to offer it unto
739 Yahweh; even that man shall be cut off from among his people.

740 ¹⁰ And whatsoever man [there be] of the house of Yisraal, or of the strangers that
741 sojourn among you, that eateth any manner of blood; I will even set my face against that
742 soul that eateth blood, and will cut him off from among his people.

743 **The Book of the Covenant of life of All Flesh in the Blood**

744 **Lev 17:11-16 KJV**

745 ¹¹ **For the life of the flesh [is] in the blood**; and I have given it to you upon the altar to
746 make an atonement for your souls: for it [is] the blood [that] maketh an atonement for
747 the soul.

748 ¹² Therefore I said unto the children of Yisraal, No soul of you shall eat blood, neither
749 shall any stranger that sojourneth among you eat blood.

750 ¹³ And whatsoever man [there be] of the children of Yisraal, or of the strangers that
751 sojourn among you, which hunteth and catcheth any beast or fowl that may be eaten;
752 he shall even **pour out the blood thereof**, and **cover it with dust**.

753 • And Yahweh's Magistrate formed man [of] the **dust of the ground**, and
754 breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. - Gen 2:7
755 KJV

756 • And Yahweh's Magistrate said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this,
757 thou [art] cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; **upon thy**
758 **belly** shalt thou go, and **dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life**: - Gen 3:14 KJV

759 **A** **Whatsoever goeth upon the belly**, and whatsoever goeth upon [all] four,
760 or whatsoever hath more feet among all creeping things that creep upon
761 the earth, them ye shall not eat; **for they [are] an abomination**. - Lev 11:42
762 KJV

763 **B** And upon her forehead [was] a name written, MYSTERY, **BABYLON THE**
764 **GREAT**, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND **ABOMINATIONS OF THE**
765 **EARTH**. - Rev 17:5 KJV

766 **C** And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and
767 Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth,
768 and his angels were cast out with him. - Rev 12:9 KJV

769 **D** And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and
770 Satan, and bound him a thousand years, - Rev 20:2 KJV

771 • And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and
772 her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel. - Gen 3:15 KJV

773 • In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for
774 out of it wast thou taken: **for dust thou [art], and unto dust shalt thou return**. -
775 Gen 3:19 KJV

776 ¹⁴ **For [it is] the life of all flesh; the blood of it [is] for the life thereof**: therefore I
777 said unto the children of Yisraal, Ye shall eat the blood of no manner of flesh: **for the**
778 **life of all flesh [is] the blood thereof**: whosoever eateth it shall be cut off.

779 • Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of
780 Yahweh; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption. - 1Co 15:50 KJV

781 • For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against
782 powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual
783 wickedness in high [places]. - Eph 6:12 KJV

784 • Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself
785 likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had
786 the power of death, that is, the devil; - Heb 2:14 KJV

- 787 • Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is
788 mine: **the soul that sinneth, it shall die.** - Eze 18:4 KJV
- 789 For the wages of sin [is] death; but the gift of Yahweh [is] eternal life through Yahshua
790 Messiah our Ruler. - Rom 6:23 KJV
- 791 • And Yahweh's Magistrate commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the
792 garden thou mayest freely eat: - Gen 2:16 KJV
- 793 • But of **the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it:** for
794 in the day that thou eatest thereof **thou shalt surely die.** - Gen 2:17 KJV
- 795 • Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous,
796 even as he is righteous. - 1Jo 3:7 KJV
- 797 • **He that committeth sin is of the devil;** for the devil sinneth from the beginning.
798 For this purpose the Son of Yahweh was manifested, that he might destroy the
799 works of the devil. - 1Jo 3:8 KJV
- 800 • Whosoever is born of Yahweh doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him:
801 and he cannot sin, because he is born of Yahweh. - 1Jo 3:9 KJV
- 802 ¹⁵ And every soul that eateth that which died [of itself], or that which was torn [with
803 beasts, whether it be] one of your own country, or a stranger, he shall both wash his
804 clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even: then shall he be
805 clean.
- 806 ¹⁶ But if he wash [them] not, nor bathe his flesh; then he shall bear his iniquity.
- 807 **All Flesh**
- 808 And they fell upon their faces, and said, O Father, the Father of the spirits of **all flesh**,
809 shall one man sin, and wilt thou be wroth with all the congregation? Num 16:22 KJV
- 810 Let Yahweh, the Father of the spirits of **all flesh**, set a man over the congregation, Num
811 27:16 KJV
- 812 **All flesh** shall perish together, and man shall turn again unto dust. Job 34:15 KJV
- 813 The voice said, Cry. And he said, What shall I cry? **All flesh** [is] grass, and all the
814 goodness thereof [is] as the flower of the field: Isa 40:6 KJV
- 815 The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: because the spirit of Yahweh bloweth upon it:
816 surely the people [is] grass. Isa 40:7 KJV
- 817 Behold, I [am] Yahweh, the Father of **all flesh**: is there any thing too hard for me? Jer
818 32:27 KJV
- 819 And it shall come to pass afterward, [that] I will pour out my spirit upon **all flesh**; and
820 your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your
821 young men shall see visions: Joe 2:28 KJV

822 And **all flesh** shall see the salvation of Yahweh. Luk 3:6 KJV

823 As thou hast given him power over **all flesh**, that he should give eternal life to as many
824 as thou hast given him. Jhn 17:2 KJV

825 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith Yahweh, I will pour out of my Spirit upon
826 **all flesh**: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall
827 see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: Act 2:17 KJV

828 For **all flesh** [is] as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass
829 withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away: 1Pe 1:24 KJV

830 Blood Covering upon the Lintel

831 Then Moses called for all the elders of Israel, and said unto them, Draw out and take
832 you a lamb according to your families, and kill the passover. - Exo 12:21 KJV

833 And ye shall take a bunch of hyssop, and dip [it] in the blood that [is] in the bason, and
834 strike **the lintel** and the two side posts with the blood that [is] in the bason; and none of
835 you shall go out at the door of his house until the morning. - Exo 12:22 KJV

836 Exo 12:23-29 KJV

837 For Yahweh will pass through to smite the Egyptians; and when he seeth the blood
838 upon **the lintel**, and on the two side posts, Yahweh will pass over the door, and will not
839 suffer the destroyer to come in unto your houses to smite [you].

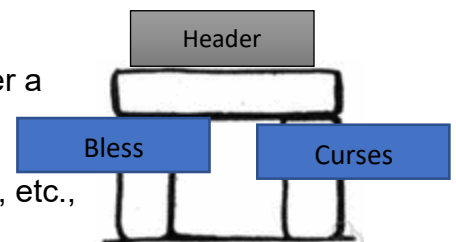

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850 And ye shall observe this thing for an ordinance to thee and to thy sons for ever.

851 And it shall come to pass, when ye be come to the land which Yahweh will give you,
852 according as he hath promised, that ye shall keep this service.

853 And it shall come to pass, when your children shall say unto you, What mean ye by this
854 service?

855 That ye shall say, It [is] the sacrifice of Yahweh's passover, who passed over the
856 houses of the children of Yisraal in Egypt, when he smote the Egyptians, and delivered
857 our houses. And the people bowed the head and worshipped.

858 And the children of Yisraal went away, and did as Yahweh had commanded Moses and
859 Aaron, so did they.

860 And it came to pass, that at midnight Yahweh smote all the firstborn in the land of
861 Egypt, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sat on his throne unto the firstborn of the
862 captive that [was] in the dungeon; and all the firstborn of cattle.

863 **Exo 12:30-36 KJV**

864 And Pharaoh rose up in the night, he, and all his servants, and all the Egyptians; and
865 there was a great cry in Egypt; for [there was] not a house where [there was] not one
866 dead.

867 And he called for Moses and Aaron by night, and said, Rise up, [and] get you forth from
868 among my people, both ye and the children of Yisraal; and go, serve Yahweh, as ye
869 have said.

870 Also take your flocks and your herds, as ye have said, and be gone; and bless me also.

871 And the Egyptians were urgent upon the people, that they might send them out of the
872 land in haste; for they said, We [be] all dead [men].

873 And the people took their dough before it was leavened, their kneadingtroughs being
874 bound up in their clothes upon their shoulders.

875 And the children of Yisraal did according to the word of Moses; and they borrowed of
876 the Egyptians jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment:

877 And Yahweh gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they lent unto
878 them [such things as they required]. And they spoiled the Egyptians.

879 **Exo 12:37-43 KJV**

880 And the children of Yisraal journeyed from Rameses to Succoth, about six hundred
881 thousand on foot [that were] men, beside children.

882 And a mixed multitude went up also with them; and flocks, and herds, [even] very much
883 cattle.

884 And they baked unleavened cakes of the dough which they brought forth out of Egypt,
885 for it was not leavened; because they were thrust out of Egypt, and could not tarry,
886 neither had they prepared for themselves any victual.

887 Now the sojourning of the children of Yisraal, who dwelt in Egypt, [was] four hundred
888 and thirty years.

889 And it came to pass at the end of the four hundred and thirty years, even the selfsame
890 day it came to pass, that all the hosts of Yahweh went out from the land of Egypt.

891 It [is] a night to be much observed unto Yahweh for bringing them out from the land of
892 Egypt: this [is] that night of Yahweh to be observed of all the children of Yisraal in their
893 generations.

894 And Yahweh said unto Moses and Aaron, **This [is] the ordinance of the passover:**
895 There shall no stranger eat thereof:

896 **Exo 12:44-51 KJV**

897 But every man's servant that is bought for money, when thou hast circumcised him, then
898 shall he eat thereof.

899 A foreigner and an hired servant shall not eat thereof.

900 **In one house shall it be eaten; thou shalt not carry forth ought of the flesh abroad**
901 **out of the house; neither shall ye break a bone thereof.**

902 All the congregation of Yisraal shall keep it.

903 And when a stranger shall sojourn with thee, and will keep the passover to Yahweh, let
904 all his males be circumcised, and then let him come near and keep it; and he shall be as
905 one that is born in the land: for no uncircumcised person shall eat thereof.

906 **One law shall be to him that is homeborn, and unto the stranger that sojourneth**
907 **among you.**

908 Thus did all the children of Yisraal; as Yahweh commanded Moses and Aaron, so did
909 they. Exo 12:50 KJV

910 And it came to pass the selfsame day, [that] Yahweh did bring the children of Yisraal out
911 of the land of Egypt by their armies. Exo 12:51 KJV

912 **Blood in the Bason covers those the lamb was Sacrificed**

913 And ye shall take a bunch of hyssop, and dip [it] in the blood that [is] in the **bason**, and
914 strike the lintel and the two side posts with the blood that [is] in the **bason**; and none of
915 you shall go out at the door of his house until the morning. Exo 12:22 KJV

1014 And it was found written, that Mordecai had told of Bigthana and Teresh, two of the
 1015 king's chamberlains, the keepers of the **door**, who sought to lay hand on the king
 1016 Ahasuerus. ^{Est 6:2 KJV}

1091 Their sorrows shall be multiplied [that] hasten [after] another [god]: their drink offerings
 1092 of blood will I not offer, nor take up their names into my lips. ^{Psa 16:4 KJV}

1093 And, thou son of man, thus saith Yahweh's Magistrate; Speak unto every feathered
 1094 fowl, and to every beast of the field, Assemble yourselves, and come; gather yourselves
 1095 on every side to my sacrifice that I do sacrifice for you, [even] a great sacrifice upon the
 1096 mountains of Yisraal, that ye may eat flesh, and drink blood. ^{Eze 39:17 KJV}

1097 And ye shall eat fat till ye be full, and drink blood till ye be drunken, of my sacrifice
 1098 which I have sacrificed for you. ^{Eze 39:19 KJV}

1099 For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed. ^{Jhn 6:55 KJV}

1100 After the same manner also [he took] the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is
 1101 the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink [it], in remembrance of
 1102 me. ^{1Co 11:25 KJV}

1103 • For when ye were the servants of sin, ye were free from righteousness. - ^{Rom 6:20}
 1104 ^{KJV}

1105 • Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness. - ^{Rom}
 1106 ^{6:18 KJV}

1107 • But now being made free from sin, and become servants to Yahweh, ye have
 1108 your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life. - ^{Rom 6:22 KJV}

1109 • For the law of the Spirit of life in Messiah hath Yahshua made me free from the
 1110 law of sin and death. - ^{Rom 8:2 KJV}

1111 • For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether [we be] Jews or
 1112 Gentiles, whether [we be] bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one
 1113 Spirit. - ^{1Co 12:13 KJV}

1114 • There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither
1115 male nor female: for ye are all one in Messiah Yahshua. - Gal 3:28 KJV

1116 • So then, brethren, we are not children of the bondwoman, but of the free. - Gal 4:31
1117 KJV

1118 Representation of the Blood

1119 Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye
1120 shall **drink**; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat,
1121 and the body than raiment? Mat 6:25 KJV

1122 **Drink - Strong's G4095 – *pinō* - πίνω – verb - A prolonged form of *pio* {pee'-o}; which**
1123 **(together with another form *poo* {po'-o}, occurs only as an alternate in certain tenses –**

- 1124 1. to drink
1125 2. figuratively, to receive into the soul what serves to refresh strengthen, nourish it unto life
1126 eternal

1127 Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we **drink**? or,
1128 Wherewithal shall we be clothed? Mat 6:31 KJV

1129 For John came neither eating nor **drinking**, and they say, He hath a devil. Mat 11:18 KJV

1130 The Son of man came eating and drinking, and they say, Behold a man gluttonous, and
1131 a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners. But wisdom is justified of her children.
1132 Mat 11:19 KJV

1133 But Yahshua answered and said, Ye know not what ye ask. Are ye able to drink of the
1134 cup that I shall drink of, and to be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with?
1135 They say unto him, We are able. Mat 20:22 KJV

1136 And he saith unto them, Ye shall drink indeed of my cup, and be baptized with the
1137 baptism that I am baptized with: but to sit on my right hand, and on my left, is not mine
1138 to give, but [it shall be given to them] for whom it is prepared of my Father. Mat 20:23 KJV

1139 And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave [it] to them, saying, Drink ye all of it; Mat
1140 26:27 KJV

1141 But I say unto you, I will not drink henceforth of this fruit of the vine, until that day when I
1142 drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom. Mat 26:29 KJV

1143 He went away again the second time, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if this cup may
1144 not pass away from me, except I drink it, thy will be done. Mat 26:42 KJV

1145 • For when ye were the servants of sin, ye were free from righteousness. - Rom 6:20
1146 KJV

1147 • Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness. - Rom
1148 6:18 KJV

- 1149 • But now being made free from sin, and become servants to Yahweh, ye have
1150 your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life. - Rom 6:22 KJV
- 1151 • For the law of the Spirit of life in Messiah hath Yahshua made me free from the
1152 law of sin and death. - Rom 8:2 KJV
- 1153 • For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether [we be] Jews or
1154 Gentiles, whether [we be] bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one

1160 Understanding Life and Death

- 1161 Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which
1162 also ye have received, and wherein ye stand; - 1Co 15:1 KJV
- 1163 By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye
1164 have believed in vain. - 1Co 15:2 KJV
- 1165 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Messaih died for
1166 our sins according to the scriptures; - 1Co 15:3 KJV
- 1167 And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:
1168 - 1Co 15:4 KJV
- 1169 And that he was seen of Cephas, then of the twelve: - 1Co 15:5 KJV
- 1170 After that, he was seen of above five hundred brethren at once; of whom the greater
1171 part remain unto this present, but some are **fallen asleep**. - 1Co 15:6 KJV
- 1172 After that, he was seen of James; then of all the apostles. - 1Co 15:7 KJV
- 1173 And last of all he was seen of me also, as of **one born out of due time**. - 1Co 15:8 KJV
- 1174 **For I am the least of the apostles**, that am not meet to be called an apostle, **because**
1175 **I persecuted the church of Yahweh**. - 1Co 15:9 KJV
- 1176 But by the grace of Yahweh I am what I am: and his grace which [was bestowed] upon
1177 me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace
1178 of Yahweh which was with me. - 1Co 15:10 KJV
- 1179 Therefore whether [it were] I or they, so we preach, and so ye believed. - 1Co 15:11 KJV

1180 Messiah has rose from the Dead

- 1181 Now if Messiah be preached that he rose from the dead, how say some among you that
1182 there is no resurrection of the dead? - 1Co 15:12 KJV
- 1183 But if there be no resurrection of the dead, then is Messiah not risen: - 1Co 15:13 KJV
- 1184 And if Messiah be not risen, then [is] our preaching vain, and your faith [is] also vain. -
1185 1Co 15:14 KJV
- 1186 Yea, and we are found false witnesses of Yahweh; because we have testified of
1187 Yahweh that he raised up Messiah: whom he raised not up, if so be that the dead rise
1188 not. - 1Co 15:15 KJV
- 1189 For if the dead rise not, then is not Messiah raised: - 1Co 15:16 KJV
- 1190 And if Messiah be not raised, your faith [is] vain; ye are yet in your sins. - 1Co 15:17 KJV
- 1191 Then they also which are **fallen asleep** in Messiah are perished. - 1Co 15:18 KJV
- 1192 If in this life only we have hope in Messiah, we are of all men most miserable. - 1Co 15:19
1193 KJV
- 1194 **But now is Messiah risen from the dead**, [and] become the firstfruits of them that
1195 slept. - 1Co 15:20 KJV
- 1196 For since by man [came] death, by man [came] also the resurrection of the dead. - 1Co
1197 15:21 KJV
- 1198 For as in Adam all die, even so in Messiah shall all be made alive. - 1Co 15:22 KJV
- 1199 But every man in his own order: Messiah the firstfruits; afterward they that are
1200 Messiah's at his coming. - 1Co 15:23 KJV
- 1201 Then [cometh] the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to Yahweh, even
1202 the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power. - 1Co 15:24
1203 KJV
- 1204 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. - 1Co 15:25 KJV
- 1205 The last enemy [that] shall be destroyed [is] death. - 1Co 15:26 KJV
- 1206 For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under [him,
1207 it is] manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him. - 1Co 15:27 KJV
- 1208 And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be
1209 subject unto him that put all things under him, that Yahweh may be all in all. - 1Co 15:28 KJV
- 1210 Else what shall they do which are baptized for the dead, if the dead rise not at all? why
1211 are they then baptized for the dead? - 1Co 15:29 KJV
- 1212 And why stand we in jeopardy every hour? - 1Co 15:30 KJV

1213 I protest by your rejoicing which I have in Messiah Yahshua our Ruler, I die daily. - ^{1Co}
 1214 15:31 KJV

1215 If after the manner of men I have fought with beasts at Ephesus, what advantageth it
 1216 me, if the dead rise not? let us eat and drink; for to morrow we die. - ^{1Co} 15:32 KJV

1217 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners. - ^{1Co} 15:33 KJV

1218 **Awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of**
 1219 **Yahweh:** I speak [this] to your shame. - ^{1Co} 15:34 KJV

1220 How are the dead raised up

1221 But some [man] will say, How are the dead raised up? and with what body do they
 1222 come? - ^{1Co} 15:35 KJV

1223 **[Thou] fool, that which thou sowest is not quickened, except it die:** - ^{1Co} 15:36 KJV

1224 And that which thou sowest (scatter), thou sowest not that body that shall be, but bare
 1225 grain (seed), it may chance of wheat, or of some other [grain]: - ^{1Co} 15:37 KJV

1226 **But Yahweh giveth it a body** as it hath pleased him, and **to every seed his own**
 1227 **body.** - ^{1Co} 15:38 KJV

1228 **All flesh [is] not the same flesh:** but [there is] one [kind of] flesh of men, another flesh
 1229 of beasts, another of fishes, [and] another of birds. - ^{1Co} 15:39 KJV

1230 [There are] also celestial bodies, and bodies terrestrial: but the glory of the celestial [is]
 1231 one, and the [glory] of the terrestrial [is] another. - ^{1Co} 15:40 KJV

1232 [There is] one glory of the sun, and another glory of the moon, and another glory of the
 1233 stars: for [one] star differeth from [another] star in glory. - ^{1Co} 15:41 KJV

1234 So also [is] the resurrection of the dead. It is sown in corruption; it is raised in
 1235 incorruption: - ^{1Co} 15:42 KJV

1236 It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power: -
 1237 ^{1Co} 15:43 KJV

1238 It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. **There is a natural body,** and
 1239 there is a spiritual body. - ^{1Co} 15:44 KJV

1240 And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam [was
 1241 made] a quickening spirit. - ^{1Co} 15:45 KJV

1242 Howbeit that [was] not first which is spiritual, but that which is natural; and afterward that
 1243 which is spiritual. - ^{1Co} 15:46 KJV

1244 The first man [is] of the earth, earthy: the second man [is] Yahweh from heaven. - ^{1Co}
 1245 15:47 KJV

1246 As [is] the earthy, such [are] they also that are earthy: and as [is] the heavenly, such
1247 [are] they also that are heavenly. - 1Co 15:48 KJV

1248 And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the
1249 heavenly. - 1Co 15:49 KJV

1250 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of Yahweh;
1251 neither doth corruption inherit incorruption. - 1Co 15:50 KJV

1252 Whatsoever thy hand findeth to do, do [it] with thy might; for [there is] no work, nor
1253 device, nor knowledge, nor wisdom, in the grave, whither thou goest. - Ecc 9:10 KJV

1254 **Grave - Strong's H7585 - שׁוֹל – שְׁוֹל – feminine noun - From שָׁוָה (H7592) –**

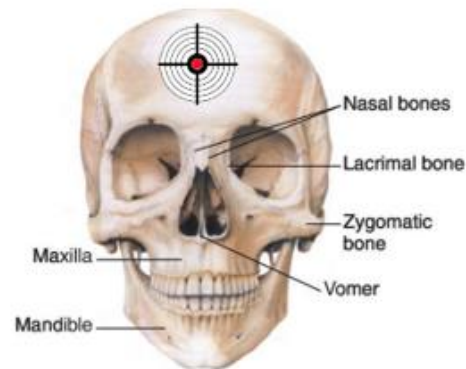
- 1255 1. sheol, underworld, grave, hell, pit

1264 **(Strong's Definitions Legend) – H7585 - שְׁוֹל shə'ôwl, sheh-ole'; or שָׁוָה shə'ôl; from H7592;**
1265 **hades or the world of the dead (as if a subterranean retreat), including its accessories and inmates:—**
1266 **grave, hell, pit.**

1267 And I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels, Go your ways,
1268 and pour out the vials of the wrath of Yahweh upon the earth. - Rev 16:1 KJV

1269 And the first went, and poured out his vial upon the earth; and there fell a noisome and
1270 grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and [upon] **them which**
1271 **worshipped his image.** - Rev 16:2 KJV

- 1272 • And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them:
1273 and [I saw] the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Yahshua,
1274 and for the word of Yahweh, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his
1275 image, **neither had received [his] mark upon their foreheads,** or in their
1276 hands; and they lived and reigned with Messiah a thousand years. - Rev 20:4 KJV



1277 **This mark upon the forehead of the cross is the pagan worship of Tammuz which**
 1278 **is the Mark of Death.**

1279 • And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles
 1280 before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast,
 1281 and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of
 1282 fire burning with brimstone. - Rev 19:20 KJV

1283 And the second angel poured out his vial upon the sea; and it became as the blood of a
 1284 dead [man]: and every living soul died in the sea. - Rev 16:3 KJV

1285 And the third angel poured out his vial upon the rivers and fountains of waters; and they
 1286 became blood. - Rev 16:4 KJV

1287 And I heard the angel of the waters say, Thou art righteous, O Lord, which art, and
 1288 wast, and shalt be, because thou hast judged thus. - Rev 16:5 KJV

1289 For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and thou hast given them blood to
 1290 drink; for they are worthy. - Rev 16:6 KJV

1291 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and
 1292 the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. - Rev 20:11 KJV

1293 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before Yahweh; and the books were
 1294 opened: and another book was opened, which is [the book] of life: and the dead were
 1295 judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. -
 1296 Rev 20:12 KJV

1297 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and **death and hell** delivered up the
 1298 dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. -
 1299 Rev 20:13 KJV

1300 **Jhn 5:28-30 KJV**

1301 Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall
 1302 hear his voice,²⁸ And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection
 1303 of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.²⁹ I can of mine
 1304 own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not
 1305 mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me. ³⁰

1306 And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children
 1307 of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a
 1308 nation [even] to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every
 1309 one that shall be found written in the book. - Dan 12:1 KJV

1310 And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting
 1311 life, and some to shame [and] everlasting contempt. - Dan 12:2 KJV

1312 • He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that
 1313 overcometh shall not be hurt of **the second death**. - Rev 2:11 KJV

1314 • Blessed and holy [is] he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such **the**
 1315 **second death** hath no power, but they shall be priests of Yahweh and of
 1316 Messiah, and shall reign with him a thousand years. - Rev 20:6 KJV

1317 • And **death and hell** were cast into the lake of fire. **This is the second death.** -
 1318 Rev 20:14 KJV

1319 • But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and
 1320 whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in
 1321 the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is **the second death**. - Rev
 1322 21:8 KJV

1323 • And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone,
 1324 where the beast and the false prophet [are], and **shall be tormented day and**
 1325 **night for ever and ever.** - Rev 20:10 KJV

1326 Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine:
 1327 the soul that sinneth, it shall die. - Eze 18:4 KJV

1328 For the wages of sin [is] death; but the gift of Yahweh [is] eternal life through Yahshua
 1329 Messiah our Ruler. - Rom 6:23 KJV

1330 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, - ^{1Co}
 1331 15:51 KJV

1332 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound,
 1333 and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. - ^{1Co} 15:52 KJV

1334 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal [must] put on immortality. -
 1335 ^{1Co} 15:53 KJV

1336 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on
 1337 immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed
 1338 up in victory. - 1Co 15:54 KJV

1339 O death, where [is] thy sting? O grave, where [is] thy victory? - 1Co 15:55 KJV

1340 The sting of death [is] sin; and the strength of sin [is] the law. - 1Co 15:56 KJV

1341 But thanks [be] to Yahweh, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Yahshua
 1342 Messiah. - 1Co 15:57 KJV

1343 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the
 1344 work of the Lord, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in the Lord. - 1Co
 1345 15:58 KJV

1346 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that
 1347 overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death. - Rev 2:11 KJV

1348 Blessed and holy [is] he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death
 1349 hath no power, but they shall be priests of Yahweh and of Messiah, and shall reign with
 1350 him a thousand years. - Rev 20:6 KJV

1351 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. - Rev 20:14 KJV

1352 But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and
 1353 whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the
 1354 lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death. - Rev 21:8 KJV

1355 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to
 1356 make war against him that sat on the horse, and against his army. - Rev 19:19 KJV

1357 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before
 1358 him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them
 1359 that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with
 1360 brimstone. - Rev 19:20 KJV

1361 And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a
 1362 great chain in his hand. - Rev 20:1 KJV

1363 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and
 1364 bound him a thousand years, - Rev 20:2 KJV

1365 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he
 1366 should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after
 1367 that he must be loosed a little season. - Rev 20:3 KJV

1368 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and [I
 1369 saw] the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Yahshua, and for the word
 1370 of Yahweh, and which had not worshipped the beast, **neither had**

1371 **received [his] mark upon their foreheads,** or in their hands; and they lived and
 1372 reigned with Messiah a thousand years. - Rev 20:4 KJV

1373 But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This [is]
 1374 the first resurrection. - Rev 20:5 KJV

1375 • **In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread,** till thou return unto the ground
 1376 (Hell, Sheol); for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou [art], and unto dust shalt
 1377 thou return. - Gen 3:19 KJV

1378 And Yahweh's Magistrate said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done
 1379 this, thou [art] cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field;
 1380 upon thy belly shalt thou go, and **dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy**
 1381 **life:** - Gen 3:14 KJV

1382 Whose end [is] destruction, whose God [is their] belly, and [whose] glory
 1383 [is] in their shame, who mind earthly things.) - Phil 3:19 KJV

1384 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are
 1385 after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. - Rom 8:5 KJV

1386 For to be carnally minded [is] death; but to be spiritually minded [is] life and
 1387 peace. - Rom 8:6 KJV

1388 Because the carnal mind [is] enmity against Yahweh: for it is not subject to the
 1389 law of Yahweh, neither indeed can be. - Rom 8:7 KJV

1390 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please Yahweh. - Rom 8:8 KJV

1391 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of Yahweh
 1392 dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Messiah, he is none of his. -
 1393 Rom 8:9 KJV

1394 And if Messiah [be] in you, the body [is] dead because of sin; but the Spirit [is] life
 1395 because of righteousness. - Rom 8:10 KJV

1396 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Yahshua from the dead dwell in you, he that
 1397 raised up Messiah from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his
 1398 Spirit that dwelleth in you. - Rom 8:11 KJV

1399 Blessed and holy [is] he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death
 1400 hath no power, but they shall be priests of Yahweh and of Messiah, and shall reign with
 1401 him a thousand years. - Rev 20:6 KJV

1402 And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, - Rev
 1403 20:7 KJV

1404 And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog
 1405 and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom [is] as the sand of
 1406 the sea. - Rev 20:8 KJV

- 1407 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints
 1408 about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from Yahweh out of heaven, and
 1409 devoured them. - Rev 20:9 KJV
- 1410 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the
 1411 beast and the false prophet [are], and **shall be tormented day and night for ever and**
 1412 **ever.** - Rev 20:10 KJV
- 1413 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and
 1414 the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. - Rev 20:11 KJV
- 1415 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before Yahweh; and the books were
 1416 opened: and another book was opened, which is [the book] of life: and the dead were
 1417 judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. -
 1418 Rev 20:12 KJV
- 1419 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the
 1420 dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. -
 1421 Rev 20:13 KJV
- 1422 And **death** and **hell** were cast into **the lake of fire.** **This is the second death.** - Rev 20:14
 1423 KJV
- 1424 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into **the lake of fire.** -
 1425 Rev 20:15 KJV
- 1426 And came out of the graves after his resurrection, and went into the holy city, and
 1427 appeared unto many. - Mat 27:53 KJV
- 1428 And Yahshua answering said unto them, The children of this world marry, and are given
 1429 in marriage: - Luk 20:34 KJV
- 1430 But they which shall be accounted worthy to obtain that world, and the resurrection from
 1431 the dead, neither marry, nor are given in marriage: - Luk 20:35 KJV
- 1432 Neither can they die any more: **for they are equal unto the angels;** and are the
 1433 children of Yahweh, being the children of the resurrection. - Luk 20:36 KJV
- 1434 Jhn 5:25 KJV
- 1435 Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear
 1436 the voice of the Son of Yahweh: and they that hear shall live.
- 1437 For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself;
 1438 - Jhn 5:26 KJV
- 1439 And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man. -
 1440 Jhn 5:27 KJV
- 1441 **Jhn 5:28-30 KJV**

1442 Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall
 1443 hear his voice,²⁸ And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection
 1444 of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.²⁹ I can of mine
 1445 own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not
 1446 mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me. ³⁰

1447 And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children
 1448 of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a
 1449 nation [even] to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every
 1450 one that shall be found written in the book. - Dan 12:1 KJV

1451 And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting
 1452 life, and some to shame [and] everlasting contempt. - Dan 12:2 KJV

1453 And Yahweh's Magistrate formed man [of] the dust of the ground, and breathed
 1454 into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul. - Gen 2:7 KJV

1455 And Yahweh's Magistrate said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this,
 1456 thou [art] cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy
 1457 belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life: - Gen 3:14 KJV

1458 • Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye
 1459 have us for an ensample. - Phl 3:17 KJV

1460 • (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even
 1461 weeping, [that they are] the enemies of the stake of Messiah: - Phl 3:18 KJV

1462 • Whose end [is] destruction, whose God [is their] belly, and [whose] glory
 1463 [is] in their shame, who mind earthly things.) - Phl 3:19 KJV

1464 **In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread,** till thou return unto the ground;
 1465 for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou [art], and unto dust shalt thou return. -
 1466 Gen 3:19 KJV

1467 And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn
 1468 many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever. - Dan 12:3 KJV

1469 Beginning from the baptism of John, unto that same day that he was taken up from us,
 1470 must one be ordained to be a witness with us of his resurrection. - Act 1:22 KJV

1471 And have hope toward Yahweh, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a
 1472 resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust. - Act 24:15 KJV

1473 For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also [in
 1474 the likeness] of [his] resurrection: - Rom 6:5 KJV

1475 Was Religion Nailed to the Cross

1476 And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the
 1477 people; (and they were all with one accord in Solomon's porch. - Act 5:12 KJV

- 1478 And of the rest durst no man join himself to them: but the people magnified them. - Act
1479 5:13 KJV
- 1480 And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.) -
1481 Act 5:14 KJV
- 1482 Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid [them] on beds and
1483 couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of
1484 them. - Act 5:15 KJV
- 1485 There came also a multitude [out] of the cities round about unto Yerusalem, bringing
1486 sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every
1487 one. - Act 5:16 KJV
- 1488 Then the high priest rose up, and all they that were with him, (which is the sect of the
1489 Sadducees,) and were filled with indignation, - Act 5:17 KJV
- 1490 And laid their hands on the apostles, and put them in the common prison. - Act 5:18 KJV
- 1491 But the angel of Yahweh by night opened the prison doors, and brought them forth, and
1492 said, - Act 5:19 KJV
- 1493 Go, stand and speak in the temple to the people all the words of this life. - Act 5:20 KJV
- 1494 And when they heard [that], they entered into the temple early in the morning, and
1495 taught. But the high priest came, and they that were with him, and called the council
1496 together, and all the senate of the children of Yisraal, and sent to the prison to have
1497 them brought. - Act 5:21 KJV
- 1498 But when the officers came, and found them not in the prison, they returned, and told, -
1499 Act 5:22 KJV
- 1500 Saying, The prison truly found we shut with all safety, and the keepers standing without
1501 before the doors: but when we had opened, we found no man within. - Act 5:23 KJV
- 1502 Now when the high priest and the captain of the temple and the chief priests heard
1503 these things, they doubted of them whereunto this would grow. - Act 5:24 KJV
- 1504 Then came one and told them, saying, Behold, the men whom ye put in prison are
1505 standing in the temple, and teaching the people. - Act 5:25 KJV
- 1506 Then went the captain with the officers, and brought them without violence: for they
1507 feared the people, lest they should have been stoned. - Act 5:26 KJV
- 1508 And when they had brought them, they set [them] before the council: and the high priest
1509 asked them, - Act 5:27 KJV
- 1510 Saying, Did not we straitly command you that ye should not teach in this name? and,
1511 behold, ye have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and intend to bring this man's blood
1512 upon us. - Act 5:28 KJV

1513 Then Peter and the [other] apostles answered and said, **We ought to obey Yahweh**
 1514 **rather than men.** - Act 5:29 KJV

1515 The Father of our fathers raised up Yahshua, **whom ye slew and hanged on a tree.** -
 1516 Act 5:30 KJV

1517 Him hath Yahweh exalted with his right hand [to be] a Prince and a Saviour, for to give
 1518 repentance to Yisraal, and forgiveness of sins. - Act 5:31 KJV

1519 And we are his witnesses of these things; and [so is] also the Holy Spirit, whom Yahweh
 1520 hath given to them that obey him. - Act 5:32 KJV

1521 When they heard [that], they were cut [to the heart], and took counsel to slay them. - Act
 1522 5:33 KJV

1523 Then stood there up one in the council, a Pharisee, named Gamaliel, a doctor of the
 1524 law, had in reputation among all the people, and commanded to put the apostles forth a
 1525 little space; - Act 5:34 KJV

1526 And said unto them, Ye men of Yisraal, take heed to yourselves what ye intend to do as
 1527 touching these men. - Act 5:35 KJV

1528 For before these days rose up Theudas, boasting himself to be somebody; to whom a
 1529 number of men, about four hundred, joined themselves: who was slain; and all, as many
 1530 as obeyed him, were scattered, and brought to nought. - Act 5:36 KJV

1531 After this man rose up Judas of Galilee in the days of the taxing, and drew away much
 1532 people after him: he also perished; and all, [even] as many as obeyed him, were
 1533 dispersed. - Act 5:37 KJV

1534 **And now I say unto you, Refrain from these men, and let them alone: for if this**
 1535 **counsel or this work be of men, it will come to nought:** - Act 5:38 KJV

1536 **But if it be of Yahweh, ye cannot overthrow it; lest haply ye be found even to fight**
 1537 **against Yahweh.** - Act 5:39 KJV

1538 And to him they agreed: and when they had called the apostles, and beaten [them], they
 1539 commanded that they should not speak in the name of Yahshua, and let them go. - Act
 1540 5:40 KJV

1541 And they departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted
 1542 worthy to suffer shame for his name. - Act 5:41 KJV

1543 And daily in the temple, and in every house, they ceased not to teach and preach
 1544 Yahshua Messiah. - Act 5:42 KJV

1545 In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in
 1546 putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Messiah: - Col
 1547 2:11 KJV

1548 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with [him] through the faith
1549 of the operation of Yahweh, who hath raised him from the dead. - Col 2:12 KJV

1550 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he
1551 quickened together with him, **having forgiven you all trespasses;** - Col 2:13 KJV

1552 **Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was**
1553 **contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;** - Col 2:14 KJV

1554 [And] having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly,
1555 triumphing over them in it. - Col 2:15 KJV

1556 Then Peter opened [his] mouth, and said, Of a truth I perceive that Yahweh is no
1557 respecter of persons: - Act 10:34 KJV

1558 But in every nation he that feareth him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with
1559 him. - Act 10:35 KJV

1560 The word which [Yahweh] sent unto the children of Yisraal, preaching peace by
1561 Yahshua Messiah: (he is Ruler of all:) - Act 10:36 KJV

1562 That word, [I say], ye know, which was published throughout all Judaea, and began
1563 from Galilee, after the baptism which John preached; - Act 10:37 KJV

1564 How Yahweh anointed Yahshua of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power: who
1565 went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for Yahweh
1566 was with him. - Act 10:38 KJV

1567 And we are witnesses of all things which he did both in the land of the Jews, and in
1568 Yerusalem; whom they slew and hanged on a tree: - Act 10:39 KJV

1569 Him Yahweh raised up the third day, and shewed him openly; - Act 10:40 KJV

1570 Not to all the people, but unto witnesses chosen before of Yahweh, [even] to us, who
1571 did eat and drink with him after he rose from the dead. - Act 10:41 KJV

1572 And he commanded us to preach unto the people, and to testify that it is he which was
1573 ordained of Yahweh [to be] the Judge of quick and dead. - Act 10:42 KJV

1574 And if a man have committed a sin worthy of death, and he be to be put to death, and
1575 **thou hang him on a tree:** - Deu 21:22 KJV

1576 His body shall not remain all night upon the tree, but thou shalt in any wise bury him that
1577 day; (**for he that is hanged [is] accursed of Yahweh;**) that thy land be not defiled,
1578 which Yahweh thy Father giveth thee [for] an inheritance. - Deu 21:23 KJV

1579 The Jews therefore, because it was the preparation, that the bodies should not remain
1580 upon the cross on the sabbath day, (for that sabbath day was an high day,) besought
1581 Pilate that their legs might be broken, and [that] they might be taken away. - Jhn 19:31 KJV

1582 For Messiah sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words,
1583 lest the cross of Messiah should be made of none effect. - 1Co 1:17 KJV

1584 And that he might reconcile both unto Yahweh in one body by the cross, having slain
1585 the enmity thereby: - Eph 2:16 KJV

1586 (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, [that
1587 they are] the enemies of the cross of Messiah: - Phl 3:18 KJV

1588 And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things
1589 unto himself; by him, [I say], whether [they be] things in earth, or things in heaven. - Col
1590 1:20 KJV

1591 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us,
1592 and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross; - Col 2:14 KJV

1593 Looking unto Yahshua the author and finisher of [our] faith; who for the joy that was set
1594 before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of
1595 the throne of Yahweh. - Heb 12:2 KJV

1596 Yahshua Redeemed Us From the Curse of the Tree

1597 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed
1598 [is] every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to
1599 do them. - Gal 3:10 KJV

1600 • **But this people who knoweth not the law are cursed.** - Jhn 7:49 KJV

1601 But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of Yahweh, [it is] evident: for, The just
1602 shall live by faith. - Gal 3:11 KJV

1603 And the law is not of faith: but, The man that doeth them shall live in them. - Gal 3:12 KJV

1604 **Messiah hath redeemed us from the curse of the law (religion, the law of sin and**
1605 **death)**, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed [is] everyone that hangeth on
1606 a tree: - Gal 3:13 KJV

1607 That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Yahshua Messiah;
1608 that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. - Gal 3:14 KJV

1609 For even hereunto were ye called: because Messiah also suffered for us, leaving us an
1610 example, that ye should follow his steps: - 1Pe 2:21 KJV

1611 Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: - 1Pe 2:22 KJV

1612 Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but
1613 committed [himself] to him that judgeth righteously: - 1Pe 2:23 KJV

1614 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins,
1615 should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. - 1Pe 2:24 KJV

1616 For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop
1617 of your souls. - 1Pe 2:25 KJV

1618 We are set free from the Law of Sin and Death

1619 [There is] therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Yahshua Messiah, who
1620 walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. - Rom 8:1 KJV

1621 **For the law of the Spirit of life in Yahshua Messiah hath made me free from the**
1622 **law (*religion*) of sin and death.** - Rom 8:2 KJV

- 1623 • And your covenant with **death** shall be **disannulled**, and your **agreement** with
1624 hell shall not stand; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, then ye
1625 shall be trodden down by it. Isa 28:18 KJV

1626 **Death - Strong's H4194 – *maveth* – מָוֶת - masculine noun - From מָוֶת (H4191) –**

1674 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh,
 1675 but after the Spirit. - Rom 8:4 KJV

1676 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after
 1677 the Spirit the things of the Spirit. - Rom 8:5 KJV

1678 **For to be carnally minded [is] death; but to be spiritually minded [is] life and**
 1679 **peace.** - Rom 8:6 KJV

1680 Because **the carnal mind [is] enmity against Yahweh:** for it is not subject to the law
 1681 of Yahweh, neither indeed can be. - Rom 8:7 KJV

1682 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please Yahweh. - Rom 8:8 KJV

1683 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of Yahweh dwell in
 1684 you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Messiah, he is none of his. - Rom 8:9 KJV

1685 And if Messiah [be] in you, **the body [is] dead because of sin;** but the Spirit [is] life
 1686 because of righteousness. - Rom 8:10 KJV

1687 Therefore [we are] always confident, knowing that, **whilst we are at home in the**
 1688 **body,** we are absent from Yahweh: - 2Co 5:6 KJV

1689 (For we walk by faith, not by sight:) - 2Co 5:7 KJV

1690 We are confident, [I say], and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be
1691 present with Yahweh. - 2Co 5:8 KJV

1692 Wherefore we labour, that, whether present or absent, we may be accepted of
1693 him. - 2Co 5:9 KJV

1694 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Messiah; that every one may
1695 receive the things [done] in [his] body, according to that he hath done, whether [it
1696 be] good or bad. - 2Co 5:10 KJV

1697 Knowing therefore the terror of Yahweh, we persuade men; but we are made
1698 manifest unto Yahweh; and I trust also are made manifest in your consciences. -
1699 2Co 5:11 KJV

1700 **The flesh, which is the physical body, is the adornment of death. The fruits and**
1701 **wages of sin is Death.**

1702 • And whatsoever man [there be] of the children of Yisraal, or of the strangers that
1703 sojourn among you, which hunteth and catcheth any beast or fowl that may be
1704 eaten; **he shall even pour out the blood thereof, and cover it with dust.** - Lev
1705 17:13 KJV

1706 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Yahshua from the dead dwell in you, he that raised
1707 up Messiah from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that
1708 dwelleth in you. - Rom 8:11 KJV

1709 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh. - Rom 8:12 KJV

1710 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds
1711 of the body, ye shall live. - Rom 8:13 KJV

1712 For as many as are led by the Spirit of Yahweh, they are the sons of Yahweh. - Rom 8:14
1713 KJV

1714 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the
1715 Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. - Rom 8:15 KJV

1716 The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of Yahweh: - Rom
1717 8:16 KJV

1718 And if children, then heirs; heirs of Yahweh, and joint-heirs with Messiah; if so be that
1719 we suffer with [him], that we may be also glorified together. - Rom 8:17 KJV

1720 And again, Esaias saith, There shall be a root of Jesse, and he that shall rise to reign
1721 over the Gentiles; in him shall the Gentiles trust. - Rom 15:12 KJV

1722 That I should be the minister of Yahshua Messiah to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel
1723 of Yahweh, that the offering up of the Gentiles might be acceptable, being sanctified by
1724 the Holy Spirit. - Rom 15:16 KJV

- 1725 For I will not dare to speak of any of those things which Messiah hath not wrought by
1726 me, to make the Gentiles obedient, by word and deed, - Rom 15:18 KJV
- 1727 But I [say], that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils, and not
1728 to Yahweh: and I would not that ye should have fellowship with devils. - 1Co 10:20 KJV
- 1729 Ye know that ye were Gentiles, carried away unto these dumb idols, even as ye were
1730 led. - 1Co 12:2 KJV
- 1731 For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether [we be] Jews or Gentiles,
1732 whether [we be] bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit. - 1Co 12:13
1733 KJV
- 1734 That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Yahshua Messiah;
1735 that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. - Gal 3:14 KJV
- 1736 Wherefore remember, that ye [being] in time past Gentiles in the flesh, who are called
1737 Uncircumcision by that which is called the Circumcision in the flesh made by hands; -
1738 Eph 2:11 KJV
- 1739 If ye have heard of the dispensation of the mercy of Yahweh which is given me to you-
1740 ward: - Eph 3:2 KJV
- 1741 How that by revelation he made known unto me the mystery; (as I wrote afore in few
1742 words, - Eph 3:3 KJV
- 1743 Whereby, when ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Messiah) -
1744 Eph 3:4 KJV
- 1745 Which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is now revealed
1746 unto his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit; - Eph 3:5 KJV
- 1747 That the Gentiles should be fellowheirs, and of the same body, and partakers of his
1748 promise in Messiah by the gospel: - Eph 3:6 KJV
- 1749 Whereof I was made a minister, according to the gift of the mercy of Yahweh given unto
1750 me by the effectual working of his power. - Eph 3:7 KJV
- 1751 Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this mercy given, that I should
1752 preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Messiah; - Eph 3:8 KJV
- 1753 And to make all [men] see what [is] the fellowship of the mystery, which from the
1754 beginning of the world hath been hid in Yahweh, who created all things by Yahshua
1755 Messiah: - Eph 3:9 KJV
- 1756 To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly [places] might be
1757 known by the church the manifold wisdom of Yahweh, - Eph 3:10 KJV
- 1758 According to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Yahshua Messiah our Ruler: -
1759 Eph 3:11 KJV
- 1760 In whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of him. - Eph 3:12 KJV

1761 Wherefore I desire that ye faint not at my tribulations for you, which is your glory. - Eph
1762 3:13 KJV

1763 To whom Yahweh would make known what [is] the riches of the glory of this mystery
1764 among the Gentiles; which is Messiah in you, the hope of glory: - Col 1:27 KJV

1765 Whereunto I am ordained a preacher, and an apostle, (I speak the truth in Messiah,
1766 [and] lie not;) a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and verity. - 1Ti 2:7 KJV

1767 Whereunto I am appointed a preacher, and an apostle, and a teacher of the Gentiles. -
1768 2Ti 1:11 KJV

1769 Notwithstanding Yahweh stood with me, and strengthened me; that by me the
1770 preaching might be fully known, and [that] all the Gentiles might hear: and I was
1771 delivered out of the mouth of the lion. - 2Ti 4:17 KJV

1772 For the time past of [our] life may suffice us to have wrought the will of the Gentiles,
1773 when we walked in lasciviousness, lusts, excess of wine, revellings, banquetings, and
1774 abominable idolatries: - 1Pe 4:3 KJV

1775 Believers are Dead to Sin and Alive to Yahweh

1776 What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that mercy may abound? - Rom 6:1 KJV

1777 Yahweh forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein? - Rom 6:2 KJV

1778 Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Yahshua Messiah were baptized
1779 into his death? - Rom 6:3 KJV

1780 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Messiah was raised
1781 up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of
1782 life. - Rom 6:4 KJV

1783 For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also [in
1784 the likeness] of [his] resurrection: - Rom 6:5 KJV

1785 Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with [him], that the body of sin might be
1786 destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. - Rom 6:6 KJV

1787 **For he that is dead is freed from sin.** - Rom 6:7 KJV

1788 Now if we be dead with Messiah, we believe that we shall also live with him: - Rom 6:8 KJV

1789 Knowing that Messiah being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more
1790 dominion over him. - Rom 6:9 KJV

1791 For in that he died, **he died unto sin once**: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto Yahweh.
1792 - Rom 6:10 KJV

1793 But now is Messiah risen from the dead, [and] become the firstfruits of them that
1794 slept. - 1Co 15:20 KJV

1795 For since by man [came] death, by man [came] also the resurrection of the dead.
 1796 _ 1Co 15:21 KJV

1797 **For as in Adam all die, even so in Messiah shall all be made alive.** - 1Co 15:22
 1798 KJV

1799 But every man in his own order: Messiah the firstfruits; afterward they that are
 1800 Messiah's at his coming. - 1Co 15:23 KJV

1801 Then [cometh] the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to Yahweh,
 1802 even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and
 1803 power. - 1Co 15:24 KJV

1804 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. - 1Co 15:25 KJV

1805 The last enemy [that] shall be destroyed [is] death. - 1Co 15:26 KJV

1806 Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto Yahweh
 1807 through Yahshua Messiah our Ruler. - Rom 6:11 KJV

1808 Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof.
 1809 _ Rom 6:12 KJV

1810 Neither yield ye your members [as] instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield
 1811 yourselves unto Yahweh, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members [as]
 1812 instruments of righteousness unto Yahweh. - Rom 6:13 KJV

1813 For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law (***religion, the law***
 1814 ***of sin and death***),, but under mercy. - Rom 6:14 KJV

1815 • **Translation:** For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the
 1816 law (***religion, the law of sin and death***), but under mercy. - Rom 6:14 KJV

1817 What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law (***religion, the law of sin***
 1818 ***and death***), but under mercy? Yahweh forbid. - Rom 6:15 KJV

1819 Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to
 1820 whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness? - Rom 6:16
 1821 KJV

1822 But Yahweh be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the
 1823 heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you. - Rom 6:17 KJV

1824 **Being then made free from sin,** ye became the servants of righteousness. - Rom 6:18 KJV

1825 I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have
 1826 yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so
 1827 now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness. - Rom 6:19 KJV


1828 **For when ye were the servants of sin,** ye were free from righteousness. - Rom 6:20 KJV

1829 What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed? for the end of
 1830 those things [is] death. - Rom 6:21 KJV

1831 But now being made free from sin, and become servants to Yahweh, ye have your fruit
1832 unto holiness, and the end everlasting life. - Rom 6:22 KJV

1833 **For the wages of sin [is] death**; but the gift of Yahweh [is] eternal life through
1834 Yahshua Messiah our Ruler. - Rom 6:23 KJV

1835 **Isa 49:1KJV**

1836  ¹ Listen, O isles, unto me; and hearken, ye people, from far; Yahweh hath called me from
1837 the womb; from the bowels of my mother hath he made mention of my name.

1838 **Isle** - (Strong's Definitions Legend) – H339 - יָּי, ee; from H183; properly, a habitable spot
1839 (as desirable); **dry land**, a coast, an island:—country, isle, island.

1840 • By these were the isles of the Gentiles divided in their lands; every one after **his**
1841 **tongue**, after **their families**, in **their nations**. - Gen 10:5 KJV

1842 After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number,
1843 of **all nations**, and **kindreds**, and **people**, and **tongues**, stood before the
1844 throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their
1845 hands; - Rev 7:9 KJV

1846 And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and
1847 talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I will shew unto thee the
1848 judgment of the great whore that sitteth upon many **waters**: - Rev 17:1 KJV

1849 And he saith unto me, The waters which thou sawest, where the whore
1850 sitteth, are **peoples**, and **multitudes**, and **nations**, and **tongues**. - Rev 17:15
1851 KJV

1852 • And Yahweh said, Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one
1853 place, and let the **dry [land] appear**: and it was so. - Gen 1:9 KJV

1854 • And **Yahweh called the dry [land] Earth**; and the gathering together of the waters
1855 called he Seas: and Yahweh saw that [it was] good. - Gen 1:10 KJV

1856 Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Yahshua
1857 Messiah, even we have believed in Yahshua Messiah, that we might be justified by the
1858 faith of Messiah, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no
1859 flesh be justified. - Gal 2:16 KJV

1860 But if, while we seek to be justified by Messiah, we ourselves also are found sinners, [is]
1861 therefore Messiah the minister of sin? Yahweh forbid. - Gal 2:17 KJV

1862 For if I build again the things which I destroyed, I make myself a transgressor. - Gal 2:18
1863 KJV

1864 **For I through the law am dead to the law, that I might live unto Yahweh**. - Gal 2:19 KJV

1865 I am crucified with Messiah: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Messiah liveth in me: and
1866 the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of Yahweh, who loved
1867 me, and gave himself for me. - Gal 2:20 KJV

- 1868 I do not frustrate the grace of Yahweh: for if righteousness [come] by the law, then
 1869 Messiah is dead in vain. - Gal 2:21 KJV
- 1870 Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of
 1871 men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Messiah. - Col 2:8 KJV
- 1872 Wherefore if ye be dead with Messiah from the rudiments of the world, why, as though
 1873 living in the world, are ye subject to ordinances, - Col 2:20 KJV
- 1874 (Touch not; taste not; handle not; - Col 2:21 KJV
- 1875 Which all are to perish with the using;) after the commandments and doctrines of men?
 1876 - Col 2:22 KJV
- 1877 Which things have indeed a shew of wisdom in will worship, and humility, and
 1878 neglecting of the body; not in any honour to the satisfying of the flesh. - Col 2:23 KJV
- 1879 Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the
 1880 new moon, or of the sabbath [days]: - Col 2:16 KJV
- 1881 Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body [is] of Messiah. - Col 2:17 KJV
- 1882 Let no man beguile you of your reward in a voluntary humility and worshipping of
 1883 angels, intruding into those things which he hath not seen, vainly puffed up by his
 1884 fleshly mind, - Col 2:18 KJV
- 1885 And not holding the Head, from which all the body by joints and bands having
 1886 nourishment ministered, and knit together, increaseth with the increase of Yahweh. - Col
 1887 2:19 KJV
- 1888 In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting
 1889 off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Messiah: - Col 2:11 KJV
- 1890 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with [him] through the faith of the
 1891 operation of Yahweh, who hath raised him from the dead. - Col 2:12 KJV
- 1892 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he
 1893 quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses; - Col 2:13 KJV
- 1894 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us,
 1895 and took it out of the way, nailling it to his cross; - Col 2:14 KJV
- 1896 [And] having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly,
 1897 triumphing over them in it. - Col 2:15 KJV
