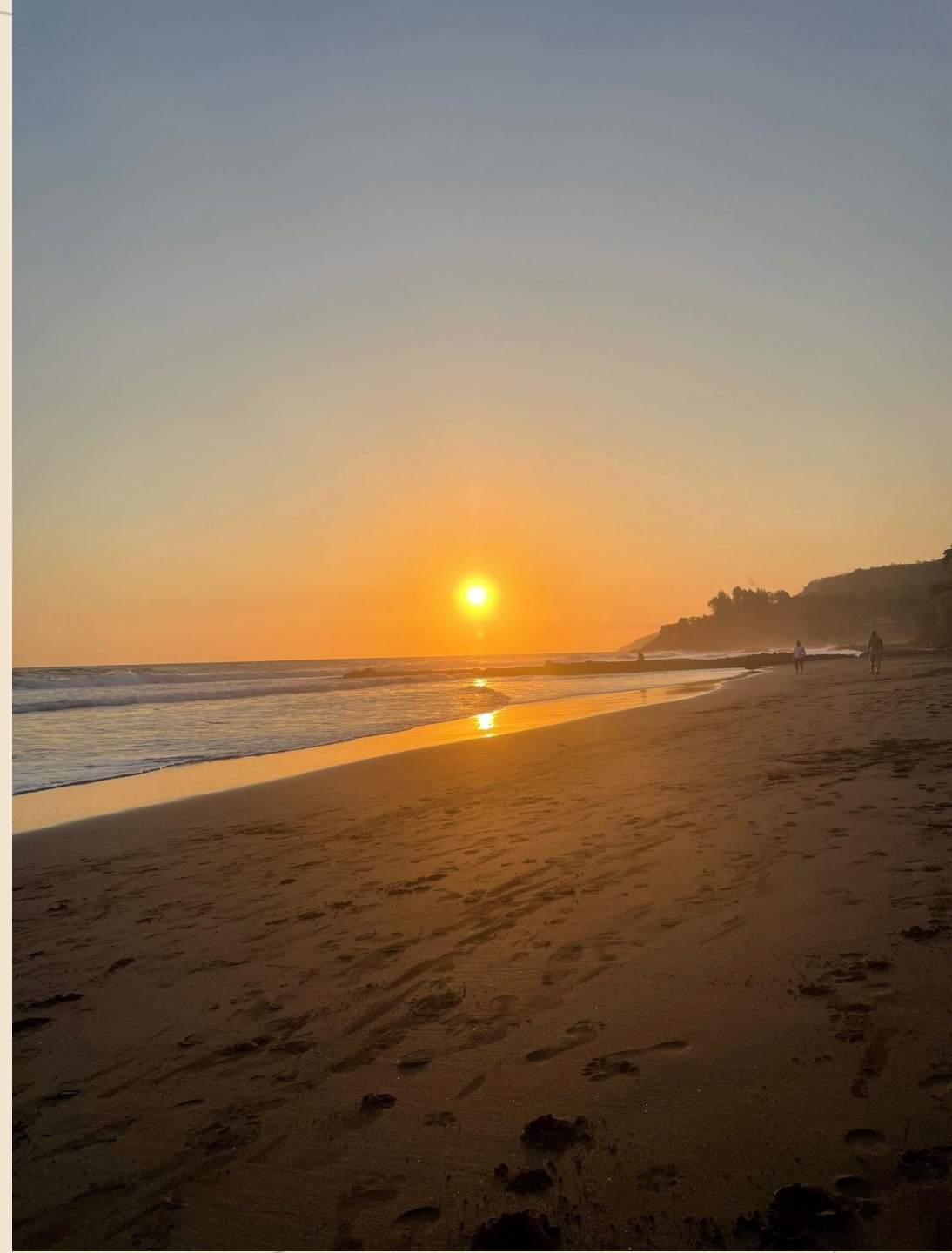


*THE POWER OF

Monsignor Romero was the keynote speaker in my high school graduation

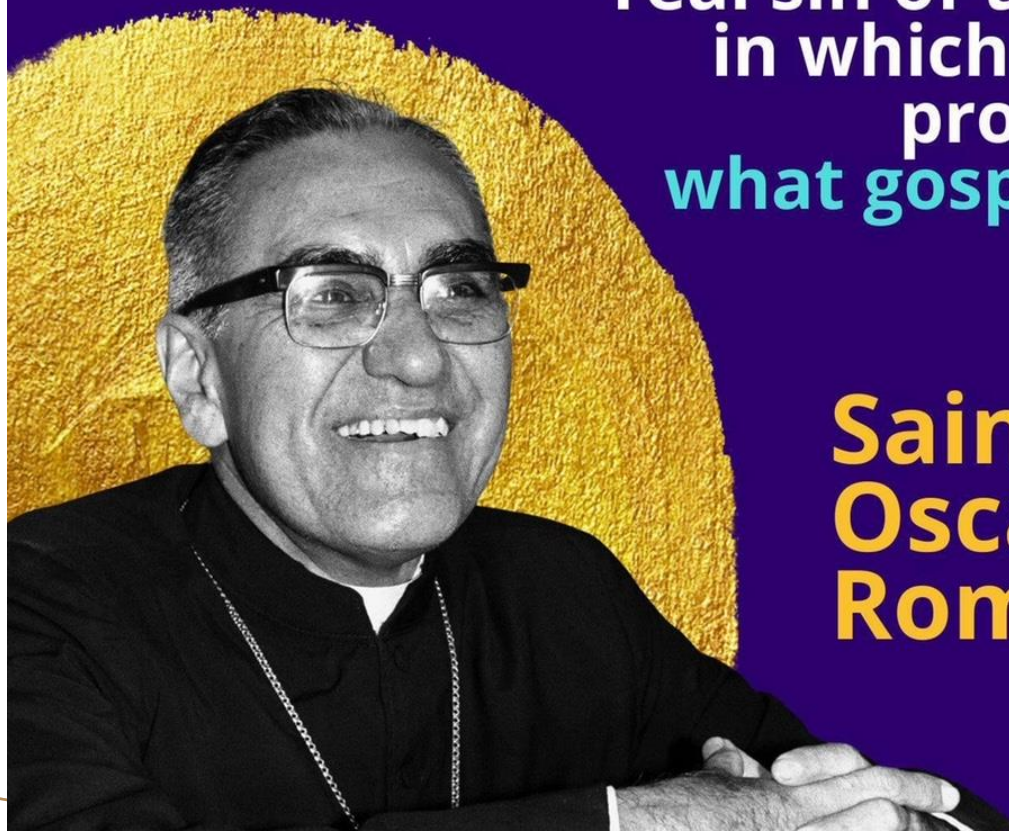
His words to us:

“COMMIT YOURSELF TO SERVE THOSE WHO ARE UNDERPRIVILEGED, YOU HAVE LIVED WITH THAT PRIVILEGE OF A GOOD LIFE, BUT YOU ARE THE SALT OF THE WORLD, SPREAD THAT SALT.”

Those words have stayed with me forever, since that night and even more when he was killed on March 24, 1980.

Have you ever heard of him?

“A church that doesn’t provoke any crises,
a gospel that doesn’t unsettle,
a word of God that doesn’t get under anyone’s skin,
a word of God that doesn’t touch the real sin of the society in which it is being proclaimed—
what gospel is that?”

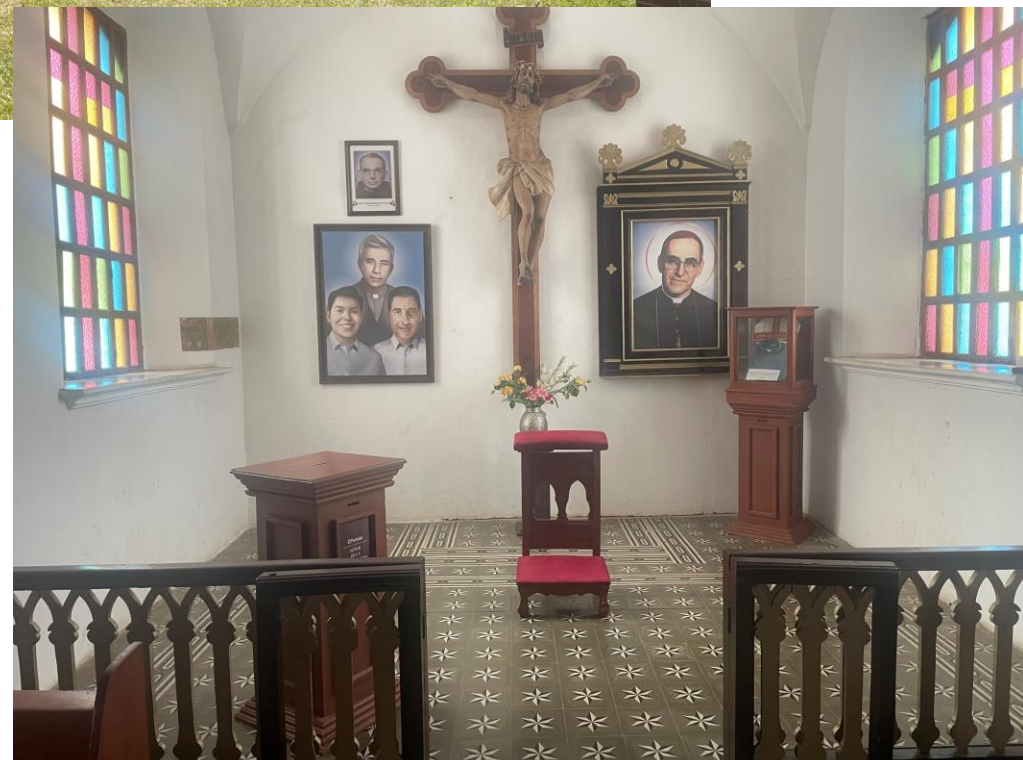
