TOPIC: THE PRAYER OF FAITH (FROM "LECTURES ON REVIVAL" BY CHARLES GRANDISON FINNEY)

Base Scripture: Mark 11:24 says "Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them."

Introduction

- 1. FAITH-an indispensable condition of prevailing prayer.
 - Faith is a component that must be present
 - What is faith
- 2. WHAT we should believe when we pray.
 - · Believe in the existence of God
 - Believe we'll receive what we asked for
- 3. WHEN we're obligated to exercise faith and believe we'll receive.
 - When we have evidence; Faith must always have evidence.

THE kinds of evidence we may receive:

- 1. WHEN God has SPECIFICALLY promised something TO US.
- 2. Where there is a particular situation or pressing issue.
- 3. Where there is a prophetic declaration agreeable to the will of God.
- 4. When the signs of the times are present
- 5. When the anointing of the Spirit of God is upon you, and excites strong desires for blessings
- 4. PRAYER in faith always obtains the sought blessing.
 - It's necessary to have expectations along with our faith as we pray



- 5. HOW to come into the state of mind where we exercise such faith.
 - 1. Cherish the good desires you have.
 - 2. Our entire consecration should be to God.
 - 3. You must persevere.
 - 4. God will tell you what to pray for
- 6. OBSERVATIONS for the prayer of faith
 - Some **must** have evidence or proof to offer the prayer of faith.
 - It's our duty to pray the prayer of faith for the salvation of men
