## MANY SPIRITUAL BLESSINGS IN CHRIST GO UNCLAIMED

Those spiritual blessings in heavenly places which are ours in Christ may be divided into three classes:

The first is those which come to us immediately upon our believing *unto salvation*, such as *Forgiveness*; *Justification*; *Regeneration*, *Son-Ship to God*, and *Baptism into the Body of Christ*. In Christ we possess these even before we know that they are <u>ours</u>!

The second class is those riches which are ours by inheritance but which we cannot enjoyed in actuality until our *Lord returns for in the Rapture*.

These include <u>ultimate mental and moral perfection</u>; The <u>glorification of our bodies</u>; The <u>completion of the restoration of</u> <u>the divine image in our redeemed personalities</u>; and the <u>admission into the very presence of God to look upon His face</u> <u>forever</u>.

The third class of *Spiritual treasures* which are ours by blood atonement, but which will not come to us unless we <u>make a</u> <u>determined effort to possess them</u>. These are deliverance from sins of the flesh; <u>victory over self</u>; the <u>constant flow of the</u> <u>Holyghost through our personalities</u>; fruitfulness in Christian service; awareness of the presence of God; growth in grace; an increasing consciousness of union with God and an unbroken spirit of worship.

These are to us, what the Promised Land was to the children of Israel, and will be entered into as our faith and courage mounts in our Lord Jesus Christ.
