Of all the Agape we take into Pasquotank Correctional Institute, nothing touches the hearts of those prisoners more than cards and letters sent by children.

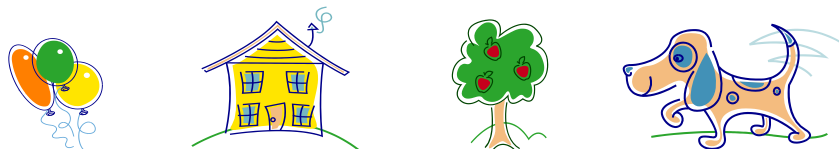

GUIDELINES:

- Please make cards from Folded Construction Paper
- Pictures can be drawn using crayon, magic marker or colored pencils
- Please do not add tape, staples, stickers, glue or glitter
- Children may sign their card, letter or poster with their **FIRST** name and age **ONLY!**
- Please do not place cards in envelopes
- If writing letters, please use unscented writing paper. These can be placed in unsealed envelopes, again signed with just first name and age.
- If making a poster try to include the names of all children participating. These are best kept to regular poster board size

Messages should be of God's love and support and our caring. They should convey the thought that these men are not forgotten and that children are praying for them. They can include a Bible verse or poem.



Pictures can be anything from flowers and animals to Bible events to rainbows to any of the happy things children put in their drawings. They don't always have to have a message added. Sometimes the pure joy expressed in the pictures is enough to lift a man's heart.

Many of these men have children of their own and receiving a card from a child can make them feel closer to their own distant families.
