## **8:15 Rules**

- 1. Attendance: Continued attendance in group activities is mandatory.
- 2. **The Beth Kaplan**: If a member is distracted in a sexual or deviant manner or if that member is reminded of a former lover during the act of hitting the ball, that member will be awarded the ability to retake that shot without penalty.
- 3. **Backwards**: If, in the normal course of hitting a golf shot, a member's golf ball goes backwards, the member will be awarded a free retake without penalty

- 5. Breakfast balls: Breakfast balls are allowed under the following stringent conditions
  - a. They may only be used on a tee shot.
  - b. A breakfast ball may be waived off if the player deems it offers no advantage.
  - c. Unused breakfast balls may be redeemed for 1 stroke.
  - d. During Saturday play, players are awarded 1 breakfast ball per nine holes.
  - e. During Sunday play, players are awarded 1 breakfast ball per 18 holes.
- 6. **Apparatus**: During the 2020 season, the club installed 3<sup>rd</sup> party after market automated ball lifters on the holes. If, during the normal course of chipping or putting the player's ball hits the ball lifter, that shot is deemed in the hole.
- 7. **Stuck tee**: If, in the normal course of teeing off, a player's tee becomes dislodged from the ground, but lands stuck back into said ground, the player is awarded a free stroke on that hole.
- 8. **The Chinese lady:** If, during the normal course of play that does not include the use of hallucinogenic drugs, a member witnesses the Chinese lady that appears out of nowhere and then disappears into a cloud of mist, that player is awarded a free stroke on that hole.

- 9. **The tee room deck**: If, during the normal course of play, a member hits a shot from anywhere in bounds on the 18<sup>th</sup> hole that flies over the building and lands <u>and stays</u> on the tee room deck will be awarded an automatic eagle.
  - a. Sunday 8:15 is indemnified from a damage to property caused by such an attempt.
  - b. If, while attempting this shot another KCC member or staff member is struck with the ball, the group will convene to determine what reasonable penalty or reward should be applied.
- 10. **Airborne advancement**: If, during the normal course of hitting a shot that is so poor that there is opportunity for the player to touch it while still airborne, that player may advance the advance the ball with any body part other than arms and hands.
  - a. If the ball strikes a player's arm or hand, that will be deemed a "handball" and a penalty stroke will be assessed.
  - b. There is opportunity for the group to assign additional reward or penalty based on style or injury that player receives.
- 11. **The multiball.** If, during the normal course of play, a member hits his or her own ball from the high fescue and that ball and one or more other balls come out, that player is awarded a free shot.
- 12. **The Group Breakfast Ball.** If on the first hole of an 8:15 sanctioned event the majority of the group is displeased with their tee shot, a vote may be taken to start the round over.
  - a. Dissenting members may play their first shot as it lays without penalty.
