



3575 S. FINDLEY AVE, BOISE, ID 83705




FACILITY LAYOUT

Facility Notes

- Lifeguards are the First Responders; Coaches/others follow their lead
- Team Tents
 - We are tenting the outside area for your use. No rental fee required.
- Spectators
 - Must remain in bleachers, behind the railing.
 - Spectator restrooms located in Lobby area.
 - Must stay off competition deck unless volunteering.
 - Volunteer positions available at wagzones2024.com
 - Apparel Vendor located outside Entrance A.

Schedule- Prelims

- ▶ Warm-Ups 6:00 AM 8:20 AM
- Competition 8:30 AM

Schedule-Finals

- Warm-Ups 3:50 PM 4:50 PM
- Competition 5:00 PM
- Finals begin at least two hours after the completion of the preliminary heats, with warm-ups scheduled to start one hour prior to the start of finals.

Scratches

- Wednesday Events: 6:00 PM Tuesday, August 6th
 - On-site or by email to mark.brown. 15@gmail.com
- Prelim Events and Relay Events:
 - On-site with Admin Referee using a scratch card
 - ▶ Deadline is 5:30 PM evening prior
- Relays & 800/1500 Freestyle athletes
 - Notify Admin Referee by scratch deadline
- > **FINALS Scratches**/Intent to Scratch:
 - On-site with Admin Referee, within 30 minutes of announcement of qualifiers

No-Shows

- Individual Prelim/Timed Finals Events- Barred from all further competition that day, including relays, and must positively check-in with Admin Referee prior to the scratch deadline in order to be seeded in subsequent day's events
- > Finals—Out of meet
- Relays—No penalty, but please scratch to allow for full heats and the best experience for all

Seeding

- ➤ Prelims—Fast to slow with the top 3 heats of 200 or less, and the top 2 heats of 400 or more are circle-seeded * Fastest Athlete in Heat 3 (Fastest Athlete in Heat 2 of 400m events).
- Finals—Slow to fast: Consolation and Championship Final

<u>Meet Operations – On Deck Admin. Referee</u>

- Declared False Starts:
 - Pre-session see the On-Deck Administrative Referee in Admin Tent
 - During the session see the Chief Judge or the Deck Referee at the Starting area.
- Questions regarding Disqualifications Report to Chief Judge in starting area.
- Special Needs or Requests Please coordinate with Mark Brown in advance (or Judi & Ryan).//

<u>Meet Operations – Relay Cards</u>

White Relay Declaration Cards can be picked up at the admin desk each morning.

Coaches should make any corrections and/or adjustments and return ALL cards to admin by 12:00pm (MDT) on the day of the relay event in order to be seeded.

Official Relay Cards will then be available at the admin desk at the start of finals warm-ups. These cards should be sent to the blocks with your swimmers.

Remember, individual no-show in prelims = may not participate on relays that day.

Meet Operations – Finals & Awards

- Finals 2 Heats in the order of Consolation and Championship Heats
 - ► Championship Final will report to their lanes & may be introduced at the starting blocks or possibly after the start. Please have athletes report directly to their lanes.
 - Alternates must be in the start area ready to swim; we will not call for alternates. They will only be called for consolation final heats.

> Awards:

- Individuals Places 1-8 (Medals)
- ► Individuals Places 9-16 (Ribbons)
- ► Relays Places 1-3 (Medals)
- ▶ Relays Places 4-8 (Ribbons)

Meet Operations - Swim-offs

- Swim-offs may be required for ties in positions for 8 & 9, 16 & 17, 18
- Check with Admin Staff before your athletes leave the venue from Prelims for any possible Swim-Offs
- ► Coaches Cell Phone #s are REQUIRED confirm at Registration Desk when checking in for the meet.

REMINDERS

- 12-Under Athletes are NOT permitted to wear tech suits.
- Provide own timers (2) 800 & 1500 Freestyles, and a person to count, if desired.
- Changing in or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms is prohibited.
- No Paddles, snorkels or Fins allowed in Competition pool or warm-down pools.
- REQUIRED: Coaches must present USAS certification to receive credential
