

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COMMUNITY WELLBEING HUB

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE

Please find key information below and read thoroughly.

Arrival Onsite

We are located at Chalfonts & Gerrards Cross Hospital, Hampden Road, Chalfont St Peter, Gerrards Cross, SL9 9DR.

The BCW Hub is located on the left-hand side of the hospital. For ease the best way to locate the Hub is to park in the hospital car park located near the main entrance. From here, you will require walking and exiting the car park and immediately turning right where you should see a small staff car park (Image 1)



As seen in image 2 there is a large Buckinghamshire Community Wellbeing Hub sign with a brown wooden gate located to the right-hand side of it. Please open the wooden gate and walk directly forward where you should see a set of white doors as displayed in image 3. Through this set of white doors is the Hub where we look forward to greeting and welcoming you to the space!

Parking

Chalfonts & Gerrards Cross Hospital offers onsite parking which is managed by Saba, please see the below tariffs:

- Up to 60 minutes: Free.
- 1 - 2 hours: £3.50.
- 2 - 3 hours: £5.
- 3 - 4 hours: £6.50.
- 4 – 24 hours: £9.

In close proximity to the Hub is Chalfont St Peter High Street where vehicles can be parked for up to 60 minutes for free.

To travel by bus to the Hub:

- Gerrards Cross Station: Bus number 104 or 106.
- Chalfont St Giles, London Road: Bus number 104 or 107.
- Seer Green Station: Bus number 104.

In addition, please note that local councils provide support to those who need assisted transport to health facilities.

Chalfonts and Gerrards Cross Hospital has dedicated disabled bays (Blue Badge spaces) which are located near to the main entrance.

Hub Opening Times

The Chalfonts and Gerrards Cross Hub is open Monday, Tuesday and Friday from 9am – 5pm.

Wi-Fi

To connect to the Hub's Wi-Fi please connect to 'BHT_Public' on your device. If working correctly an 'Acceptable Use Policy' should appear, please read thoroughly before clicking accept if you agree to the stated terms and conditions. If you are connecting on your mobile device then you may see one further pop up highlighting a 'Cookie Policy,' once accepted you should be permitted to use the Wi-Fi.

***We strongly recommend coming along and checking your internet access earlier to your session to ensure the internet is accessible to avoid any delayed start time to your session. ***

Refreshments

Refreshments are not provided in the Hub.

There is use of a kettle and fridge with washing up facilities at the Chalfonts and Gerrards Cross Hub. You will need to supply your own tea and coffee.

Use of the BCW Hub and its facilities

You are welcome to move and adjust the chairs and tables to suit your requirements within the Hub however, we ask that you please return all furniture and equipment back to its rightful place and ensure the Hub is clean and tidy before leaving. ***Please do not move the sofas (cost will be incurred if there are any damages)** There is a kitchenette available to use equipped with a small kettle, mugs, jugs and cutlery.

Equipment

A projector is available for use during your time at the BCW Hub. By rearranging the tables and chairs, the space can also be easily adapted to best suit the needs of your group, class, or activity.

Shared Working Space

The BCW Hub is a co-designed shared working space so please be aware that from time to time, there may be other facilitators and professionals using the space at the same time as yourself. Please be mindful and respectful of others and conscious of noise levels.
