The first event hosted at the hub was delivered by adult social care who ran a **'preparing for future care' session**. The overall aim of the session was to encourage individuals to work together to co produce a transparent, accessible support model including information and guidance, that makes it easier for people to get the right help when accessing adult social care for the first time. By the end of the session individuals had an understanding of; community based options that provide local & affordable care, straightforward financial advice pathways and support surrounding how to live independently for longer.

The hub hosts regular **dyslexia assessments**. These sessions include a full diagnostic assessment for individuals under 18 years of age. In addition, they aim to empower children with dyslexia to recognise their strengths, build confidence in their abilities and embrace their unique skills.

**Bluebird Care ran a nail care taster session** which enabled individuals to experience a complimentary 30 minute treatment from a nail care specialist. The sessions were designed for individuals who may find it difficult to bend or safely manage their own nail care. The event saw many local residents enjoy: nail clipping and filing, cuticle care, callus treatment, polish application and removal, touch therapy massage & skin integrity.

The hub wrapped up the month of March by running a drop in **online directory support session**.

The aim is to make it easy for patients and residents to be connected, or to connect themselves, into local support that will improve their long term health and wellbeing.
