Alejandra Oraa is a seven-time Emmy Award-winning anchor, a Peabody Award recipient, and a renowned journalist best known for her work at CNN. In 2011, at just 23 years old, she made history as CNN's youngest anchor ever. Alejandra has hosted three signature shows: Café CNN, a dynamic morning news program; Destinos, a travel and adventure series; and Cara a Cara, an intimate, in-depth interview series with influential figures.

With a versatile talent for storytelling, Alejandra has produced and written a diverse range of programming, from breaking news and investigative documentaries to talk shows. She has conducted interviews with a wide spectrum of notable individuals, including world leaders such as U.S. Secretary of State John Kerry, former British Prime Minister Gordon Brown, and ten Latin American presidents. Her conversations also extend to global icons like Gerard Piqué, Shakira, Carlos Vives, Eddie Palmieri, and Willie Colón.

Known for her passion for journalism, Alejandra's remarkable achievements and unique approach to storytelling have set her apart as a trailblazer in the field.


CNN EN ESPAÑOL'S MORNING PROGRAM
