#### APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

## 1. Jake-Braking Ordinance – Second Reading:

Motion made by Lisa Cranford, second by Willie Moss, to accept the second reading of the Jake-Braking Ordinance No. 20-12-10 and adopt the ordinance. Everyone voted in favor.

## 2. 2021 Qualifying Fees:

Motion made by Willie Moss, second by Lisa Cranford, to set the 2021 qualifying fee at \$27.00 for council as three (3) council seats are due for election in 2021. All votes were in favor of the motion.

### 3. 2021 Election Contract:

## 4. Date(s) for Officials' Pay:

## 5. November 2021 Meeting Date:

## 6. <u>Hobbs Trucking Invoice for Road Patching:</u>

Motion made by Lisa Cranford, second by Tara Parrish, to pay the Hobbs Trucking invoice in the amount of \$750.00 for patching a water leak repair site on George Street (Ga Hwy 296). All voted in favor.

### 7. Greene's Water Wells School Street Well Quote:

Mayor Parrish reviewed a letter from Greene's Water Wells regarding the analysis work that has been completed at the School Street well and Mr. Greene's recommendation/options/costs for making the well operational again. Motion made by Lisa Cranford, second by Carol Smith, to accept Mr. Greene's quote and include the optional riser pipe substitution of 80 feet of stainless steel schedule 40 riser pipe for the carbon steel riser pipe for a total project cost of \$30,612.00 to be paid from SPLOST funds. Everyone voted in favor of the motion.

## 8. Police Chief's Report:

Chief Jones presented his monthly departmental report. He requested authorization to pursue grant options for the purchase of a new police vehicle to replace the Dodge Charger. Officials approved his request by consensus.
