APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Mayor Pro tem Irby called for a motion to approve the minutes of the February 10, 2022, regular meeting. Motion made by Willie Moss, second by Janis Holley, to approve the minutes of the meeting. Everyone voted in favor of the motion.

1. Ratify Payment of Invoice for Engine 4 Repair:

Motion made by Willie Moss, second by Janis Holley, to ratify the payment of an invoice from Freightliner of Augusta dated March 4, 2022, in the amount of \$1,259.84 for repairs to Fire Engine 4. Everyone voted in favor.

2. School Street Well Filter Backwash Disposal System Estimate:

Motion made by Willie Moss, second by Janis Holley, to approve the plan and cost estimate of \$36,467.00 for the proposed filter backwash disposal system for the School Street well as prepared by G. Ben Turnipseed Engineers. The motion included the designation of this project as a water infrastructure expense allowed by the American Rescue Plan Act. Motion carried unanimously.

3. Police Chief's Report:

- a. Safety Vests Purchase

Motion made by Wille Moss, seconded by Janis Holley, to approve the purchase, using police reserve account funds, of two (2) bullet-proof vests for the police department at a cost of \$2,040.00 from SRT Supply. The vote was unanimous.
