APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

1. American Rescue Plan Act Update:

Clerk Berry apprised officials of a recent exclusion aspect of the American Rescue Plan Act that permits entities receiving less than \$10 million to claim "Revenue Replacement" as the project category for all funds received and expected, and no further project reporting would be necessary.

2. Turnipseed Engineers Invoice Approval:

Motion made by Jason Irby, second by Christopher Whipple, to approve payment of the invoice from Turnipseed Engineers in the amount of \$2,170.98 for engineering services related to the filter backwash discharge system at the School Street Well. The vote was unanimous.

3. Hodges Machine Shop Invoice Approval:

Motion made by Janis Holley, second by Christopher Whipple, to approve payment of the invoice from Hodges Machine Shop in the amount of \$908.20 for repacking the cylinders for the backhoe. Everyone voted in favor of the motion.

4. Police Chief:

In the absence of Chief Hoffman clerk Berry reported that the "bullet proof" vests recently approved for purchase had been received and issued to department personnel.
