APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Mayor Parrish called for a motion to approve the minutes of the May 14, 2020, regular meeting. Motion made by Lisa Cranford, second by Willie Moss, to approve the minutes of the meeting. Everyone voted in favor of the motion.

1. Lawn Mower Replacement:

Mayor Parrish presented bids for the replacement of the Cub Cadet lawnmower which is eight years old and presenting maintenance problems:

Motion made by Jason Irby, second by Lisa Cranford, to purchase the mower from B & W Saws and Equipment at \$7,733.33 using SPLOST funds. The vote was unanimous.

2. SPLOST Intergovernmental Agreement:

Motion made by Lisa Cranford, second by Willie Moss, to approve the 2022 SPLOST Intergovernmental Agreement between Jefferson County and the municipalities in Jefferson County. Everyone voted in favor of the motion.

3. American Tank Maintenance Invoice:

Motion made by Willie Moss, second by Jason Irby, to pay the American Tank Maintenance fourth and final annual invoice in the amount of \$9,545.50 for the School Street tank refurbishment from the Tank Maintenance Fund. Everyone voted in favor of the motion.

CITIZEN COMMENTS: There were none.

MAYOR'S REPORT: The mayor commented on several items; recognized Police Chief Jason Jones who gave the police report; and received a written complaint from Carol Smith signed by several citizens regarding the property at 508 Baker Street.
