APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Mayor Cranford called for a motion to approve the minutes of the July 14, 2022, regular meeting. Motion made by Jason Irby, second by Christopher Whipple, to approve the minutes of the meeting. Everyone voted in favor of the motion.

1. 2022 Tax Mill Rate:

Motion made by Christopher Whipple, second by Jason Irby, to publish the required 5-Year Tax History with a net mill rate of 10 mills. The vote was unanimous.

2. American Rescue Plan Act Funding:

Clerk Berry reported that the city had received the second tranche payment from the American Rescue Plan Act in the amount of \$73,380.00.

3. Police Department:

- a. Durango Repair Update – Chief Hoffman reported the Durango repair was completed at significantly less cost than expected.
- b. Radar Replacement – Chief Hoffman reported that the refurbished Stalker radar units that were purchased in 2021 have become inoperable and, due to the age of the units, no repair is available. He requested authorization for purchasing two (2) new units for the Explorer and the Durango.

Motion made by Jason Irby, second by Christopher Whipple, to approve the purchase of two (2) new radar units using police reserve account funds. All voted in favor.
