APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Mayor Parrish called for a motion to approve the minutes of the July 9, 2020, regular meeting. Motion made by Lisa Cranford, second by Willie Moss, to approve the minutes of the meeting. Everyone voted in favor of the motion.

1. 2020 Tax Mill Rate:

Motion made by Lisa Cranford, second by Willie Moss, to adopt a net mill rate of 8 mills for 2020 ad valorem taxes. The vote was unanimous.

2. CARES Act Funding Resolution:

Motion made by Lisa Cranford, second by Willie Moss, to adopt Resolution No. 8-13-20 to authorize the execution of the coronavirus relief fund terms and conditions agreement and acceptance of grant payments (CARES Act Funding). Everyone voted in favor of the motion.

3. FY 2020 Budget Amendment Ordinance and FY 2021 Budget Ordinance – Second Reading:

Motion made by Willie Moss, second by Lisa Cranford, to accept the second reading of the FY 2020 Budget Amendment Ordinance and FY 2021 Budget Ordinance and adopt the ordinances. Everyone voted in favor of the motion.

4. Tahoe Repair:

Motion made by Lisa Cranford, second by Willie Moss, to ratify the expenditure of \$1,483.30 for repair of the rear input bearing on the 2015 Chevrolet Tahoe. All voted in favor.

5. Police Report:

Police chief Jason Jones presented his monthly report and requested authorization to increase the city's fine schedule by \$35.00 per offense excluding those offenses whose mandated fine limit prohibits the increase. Motion made by Willie Moss, second by Lisa Cranford, to approve the request. The vote was unanimous.

MAYOR'S REPORT: The mayor commented on several items.
