APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

1. CARES Act Funding:

Clerk Berry informed council that CARES Act funds totaling \$20,573.00 had been reimbursed to the City for public safety payroll costs incurred during the eligible period of March 1, 2020 to June 30, 2020.

2. Police Report:

Police chief Jason Jones presented his monthly report and introduced recently hired part-time officer Glenn Edwards to the council. He noted that the new Dollar General Store expects to open in October, and he requested authorization to convert the part-time position to full-time to provide adequate police coverage. Motion made by Lisa Cranford, second by Willie Moss, to approve the request. Lisa Cranford, Willie Moss, Tara Parrish, and Carol Smith voted in favor of the motion, with Jason Irby voting in opposition. Motion carried.
