Mayor Bowser,

I am writing again to urgently follow up on the grievances my family and I previously reported to your office regarding ongoing harassment, targeted intimidation, and failures by multiple agencies to provide protection or even basic response. Since submitting those reports, the danger to me and my children has escalated significantly.

After notifying your office of the coercive control, stalking, and organized harassment we have endured for years, my children and I were **maced on Metro**—an attack that occurred in public, in daylight, and in full view of surveillance cameras. Despite the severity of this assault, Metro Transit Police closed the case without a proper investigation, without interviewing us, and without reviewing the full footage. This is not only unacceptable—it is dangerous.

Following that incident, our communications appear to have been compromised even further. Calls, emails, and online submissions to city agencies continue to go unanswered, rerouted, or blocked entirely. This pattern has persisted for years, across multiple jurisdictions, and it has left us without any reliable avenue to report threats or request emergency assistance.

I am once again requesting **immediate intervention** from your office. My family cannot continue living under these conditions. We need:

- Emergency safety assistance and relocation support
- A neutral, trauma-informed point of contact who can communicate with us securely
- A full review of the Metro assault and the pattern of harassment surrounding it
- Assurance that our reports are being received, documented, and acted upon—not dismissed or ignored

Because we have received **no response** from your office since our initial outreach, we intend to begin **peaceful, respectful protest** until our voices are heard and our safety

concerns are taken seriously. This is not a decision we take lightly. It is the only remaining option available to us after years of being silenced, dismissed, or left without protection.

We are asking—again—for your leadership, your attention, and your action. My children and I deserve safety. We deserve due process. We deserve to be heard.

I look forward to your prompt response.
