



Family Outreach Fall Carnival

The event on October 10, 2026 will run from 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM at **Collins Park, 1001 16th Ave, Conway.** Family Outreach is a nonprofit organization dedicated to preventing child abuse, neglect, and poverty by providing educational programs and services to families.

Vendor space consists of one 10' X 10' area, and vendors are responsible for bringing their own tent, tables, and chairs.

Vendors must complete set up and move their vehicle by 10:30 AM on the day of the event. Set can begin at 8:30am. We are asking vendors to donate an item for our raffle.

The deadline for application submission is Sept. 18, 2026, and spaces are assigned on a first come first serve basis. For-profit vendors are required to pay a \$45 fee while nonprofit vendors that are not selling items are exempt from this fee. FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE DUE TO CANCELLATION BY VENDOR OR RESCHEDULING. Fees are due within 48 hours of approval. Vendors must be open for business by 11:00 AM and remain open for the duration of the Fall Carnival, with early breakdown not allowed.
