The musical was written and directed by Emmy award winning director Paris Barclay. The same producers of One Red Flower: Letters from 'Nam, then contacted Levi for a new project, leading Levi to originate the role of Jerry Lee Lewis in Broadway's Million Dollar Quartet. On June 13, 2010, he received the Tony Award for "Best Featured Actor In A Musical" for the role. He also won

the Outer Critics Circle Award for Best Featured Actor In A Musical, along with a Drama League nomination. Other notable stage credits include the Tony nominated Broadway revival of Violet starring Sutton Foster, Smokey Joe's Cafe at Arena Stage, and Pump Boys And Dinettes at The Village Theater (where both One Red Flower and Million Dollar Quartet began).
