The following are the required online LIVE training sessions for the ACCA FIA Level 2 Diploma Program. Students can now begin the registration process.

Note that this is a blended learning program and in addition to the Online LIVE sessions, students will need to commit to investing weekly study time for each course. A minimum of 2 hours per course is recommended. This time will be used to review recorded lessons, complete assignments, and practice questions for topic competence.

Important Notice from the ACCA's Website:

“If you register on or before the late entry June deadline for each year, you will be invoiced the annual subscription fee as you’re eligible to sit exams in the June, September and December sessions. Check important dates. After that your annual subscription fee is due and payable on or before 1 January each year if you wish to remain an active student. We send you an invoice every November. You need to pay this even if you don’t plan to take any exams that year.

And if you forget to pay, you may be removed from the register of students and have to pay a re-registration fee, as well as any outstanding fees, to enable you to continue with your studies. Remember, you have to pay this whether or not you’re planning to take exams that year.

You can pay your fees online at myACCA. The payment enables ACCA to provide you with relevant resources and support to help you gain membership.”
