

FIRE ON THE FARM

Fire Safety Mini-Lesson Plan



Date:

Objectives

By the end of this lesson, students will be able to: - Identify basic fire safety rules (e.g., "Get low and go," "Never play with matches," "Know your meeting spot"). - Recall key events from the story. - Participate in a fire safety discussion or role-play.

Materials Needed

- Fire on the Farm storybook
- Whiteboard or chart paper Printed Fire Safety Tip Poster (from the book)
- Optional: Activity sheets or coloring pages

Lesson Plan (15–30 minutes)

- Read-Aloud (10 minutes) - Read Fire on the Farm aloud. - Ask questions like: "What do you think Sage is smelling?" or "What should PJ have done?"
- Discussion (5-10 minutes) -
 - What are some fire safety rules from the book? -
 - What should you do if you see smoke or fire? -
 - Where is your family meeting spot?
- Fire Safety Practice (5-10 minutes)
 - Stop, Drop, and Roll practice
 - Crawl low under pretend smoke (sheet or table)
 - Identify 2 exits in the classroom
- Optional Wrap-Up Activity
 - Use the Fire Safety Tips quiz page from the book
 - Do a coloring sheet or design a firefighter badge
