# Registration for New and Returning Students Begins

Saint Mary's parents—it's time to get on Sycamore and update your personal information. Re-enrolling your child is easier than ever this year. After you have updated your information, come in to the office and sign the Parent Commitment form, financial letter, and pay the registration fee—all before the end of March and your child will be registered for next year. If you are adding another child to your information, there is a place in Sycamore that says "add student" and you will be able to add that child without filling out new paperwork. We are extending the deadline for payment of registration this year to April 1<sup>st</sup>. We will have a REGISTRATION NIGHT on Monday, March 31, to catch any returning families who have not yet updated their information. In order to apply for financial aid and avoid paying the higher registration fee, update all your information on Sycamore and drop by the office to sign your forms and pay the registration fee. DEADLINE FOR RETURNING STUDENTS IS APRIL 1st
