CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK BEGINS!

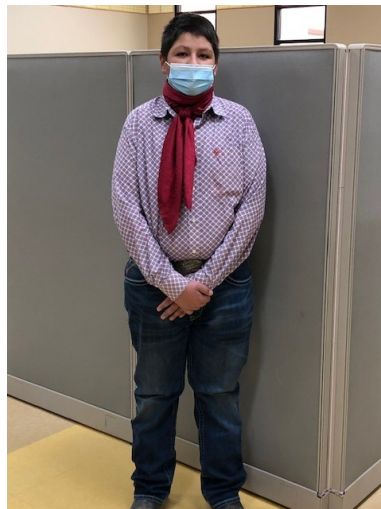
