ASH WEDNESDAY AND OUR LENTEN RETREAT



The day was spent in prayer and participating in activities to help provide our students with an opportunity for spiritual renewal as they participated in the reflections and exercises.



This Month's Class Saint and Fruit of the Holy Spirit

Second grade's assigned Fruit of the Holy Spirit was PEACE. Peace appears 329 times in the bible with the highest occurrence of 30 in the book of Isaiah. After His death and resurrection, Jesus used this greeting three times when He met with His disciples (John 20:19-29). The first thing to notice is that Jesus used this greeting of peace after His resurrection. Second grade chose St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta as their class saint. St. Mother Teresa was the founder of the Order of the Missionaries of Charity, a Roman Catholic congregation of women dedicated to helping the poor. Considered one of the 20th Century's greatest humanitarians, she was canonized as Saint Teresa of Calcutta in 2016.
