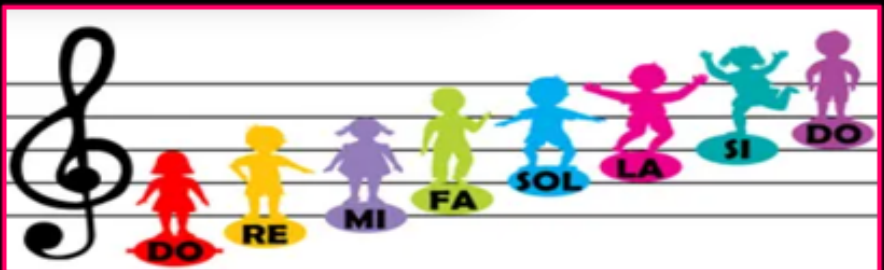
Catholic Identity

Elementary Music Curriculum (Pre-K through 5th)

- ♫ Explore sound through singing, moving, listening, and playing instruments
- ♫ Sing, move to, listen to, and present traditional children's songs, folk songs, classical music, and music from a variety of cultures, styles, and time periods as well as from our Catholic tradition.
- ♫ Perform a variety of simple songs, alone and in groups.
- ♫ Experiment with a variety of instruments.
- ♫ Improvise songs to accompany their play activities.
- ♫ Create short pieces of music, using voices and instruments.
- ♫ Respond through movement to music of various tempos, meters, dynamics, modes, genres, and styles to express what they hear and feel in works of music.

Middle School Curriculum (6th through 8th)

- ♫ Perform, using voice and instruments, music representing diverse genres and cultures as well as music from our Catholic tradition.
- ♫ Perform a variety of repertoire alone and in groups.
- ♫ Perform simple melodies by ear and produce simple harmonic accompaniments in a consistent style, meter and tonality.
- ♫ Create short pieces of music using proper musical notation including notes, rests, time signature, meter, and symbols for pitch, tempo, articulation, and expression.
- ♫ Respond to basic principles of meter, rhythm, tonality, intervals, chords, and harmonic progressions in their analyses of music.
- ♫ Research and present on a variety of genres and composers/musicians/songwriters through out all musical time periods.
